





## Mensaje del Padre Marcelo

**Queridos hermanos y hermanas,**  
**San Antonio de Padua**

Nació en Lisboa, en 1195. San Franciscano de origen portugués, sacerdote y doctor de la Iglesia.



Tenemos la bendición de tener como patrón a uno de los santos más famosos de nuestra Iglesia Católica. San Antonio de Padua es amado y venerado en todo el mundo. Pocos santos en la iglesia gozan de tal reconocimiento mundial.

Esta impresionante reverencia se debe a su extraordinaria vida y milagros. Durante sus cortos 35 años de vida, sus obras y su ejemplo tuvieron un gran impacto en la vida de la iglesia. Tenía un gran amor por la pobreza y la humildad. Promovió el amor por la Eucaristía. Tenía una gran solicitud por los pobres y los solitarios. Tenía un gran celo por el Evangelio y la salvación de las almas.

Gracias a su destacada predicación, muchos se convirtieron a la fe católica. Luchó incansablemente contra el error y la herejía que le valieron el sobrenombre de "Martillo de los herejes". También es el patrón de las cosas perdidas, que guía a las personas para que encuentren el camino de regreso a lo que sea que se estaba buscando. Cada santo patrón es elegido para ser guía y protector de una iglesia o persona en particular, pero también es elegido para ser un modelo para imitar.

### Formación religiosa

A la edad de 15 años, Santo Antônio ingresó en el Monasterio de São Vicente de Fora, donde comenzó su formación religiosa. Luego fue a estudiar al Monasterio de Santa Cruz de Coimbra, donde recibió una sólida formación filosófica y religiosa.

En 1220, San Antonio es ordenado sacerdote. Ese mismo año, se conmovió al ver el botín de los frailes franciscanos que se veneran en el Monasterio de Santa Cruz después de ser martirizados en una misión en Marruecos, en un intento de evangelizar a los moros.

Decide unirse a la orden franciscana y recibe el hábito de San Francisco en el Convento de Olivas, en Coimbra, con el nombre de Fray Antônio. Comenzó una misión a Marruecos, pero después de un año de catequesis en ese país, tuvo que dejarlo debido a una enfermedad y se fue a Italia.

Con mala salud, San Antonio se reunió en el convento de Arcella, cerca de Padua, donde escribió una serie de tardes para el domingo y los días santos.

San Antonio murió en Padua, Italia, el 13 de junio de 1231. En 1263, sus restos fueron llevados a la Basílica de San Antonio de Padua, construida en su memoria.

Estamos llamados a imitar la vida de nuestro santo patrón en sus virtudes de amor a la Iglesia, humildad, celo por el Evangelio y confianza en Dios. San Antonio de Padua es patron de las mujeres estériles pobres, albañiles, panaderos y papeleros. Que Viva San Antonio.






