Pastor's message

Dear brothers and sisters, we are coming to the third Sunday of Lenten season and today at the 9:30am we have the rite of election for a family who will receive the sacrament of Christian Initiation on Easter Vigil. I said Christian Initiation because they will receive the sacraments of Baptism, Confirmation and Holy



Communion. These are the sacraments by which we initiate our Christian life. All the sacraments come from the cross of our blessed Lord. (image below) By his passion, death and resurrection our blessed Lord brought us the sanctifying grace. The Sanctifying grace is giving in baptism. This especial grace is the same thing that Jesus is talking about to the

Samaritan woman in the Gospel of this Sunday. Jesus came across with this woman to teach her how important is to be converted and to receive the good news. Jesus draws her through what she was familiar to, she would come very often to draw water, which would tire her at time. Our Lord told her that the water He offers is something that will satisfy her thirst and needs, "whoever drinks the water I shall give will never thirst." to this news she reacts by requesting him to have this special water, "Sir, give me this water."

St. Thomas Aquinas states that there are two varieties of water: living and non-living. Non-living water is that which is not attached to the source from which it springs, but which is collected by rain or is otherwise stored in lakes or cisterns, and is kept separated from its source. Living water is that which flows and flows from the source. According to this, the grace of the Holy Spirit is rightly called living water, because the grace of the Holy Spirit is given to man in such a way that the very source of grace, that is, the Holy Spirit, is given to him, furthermore, through it (Holy Spirit)

grace is given, as the Apostle says: "The love of God has been poured out in our hearts by the Holy Spirit, whom we have received." (Rom 5:5). For the Holy Spirit is an inexhaustible fountain from which flow all the gifts of grace. The Catechism of the Catholic Church states that "the grace of Christ is the gratuitous gift that God makes to us of his own life, infused by the Holy Spirit into our soul to heal it of sin and to sanctify it." CCC 1999. This is what Christ did with the Samaritan woman, He gave her a free gift calling her to repentance and to receive freely the grace of God. May all of us listening to the good news of Christ may be converted and receive his Grace through a worthy reception of the sacraments. Happy Sunday and may you continue having a blessed Lenten Season!



DÍA DE FIESTA: 17 DE MARZO

Patricio, el santo patrón de Irlanda, nació en la Britania romana. En su corta biografía y testimonio, Confesiones, describe su vida y su ministerio, incluyendo su labor de convertir al pueblo irlandés.

A los 16 años, Patricio fue secuestrado por unos invasores irlandeses y vendido como esclavo en Irlanda. El tiempo que pasó en cautiverio, lo transformó espiritualmente. Patricio trabajó solo, como pastor, antes de escapar y regresar a casa.

Luego de regresar a casa, su sueño de convertir a los irlandeses para que no fuesen paganos, lo impulsó a estudiar para el sacerdocio en Galicia (hoy Francia). Por el año 432, el papa Celestino I lo consagró como obispo y lo envió a Irlanda. Por casi 30 años, Patricio predicó sin descanso, consiguió convertir a mucha gente, fundó monasterios y estableció la sede primacial en Armagh en lo que hoy es la moderna Irlanda del Norte.

Cerca del final de su vida, él hizo un retiro de 40 días en el monte Croagh Patrick en lo que hoy es el Condado Mayo. Esto ha dado lugar a que, hasta el día de hoy, se realicen peregrinajes a esa zona. Algunas de las leyendas sin confirmar dicen que Patricio utilizó un trébol para explicar la Trinidad y que libró de serpientes a una isla.



Mensaje del Padre Marcelo

“Dame de beber”

Hoy, como en aquel mediodía en Samaria, Jesús se acerca a nuestra vida, a mitad de nuestro camino cuaresmal, pidiéndonos como a la Samaritana: «Dame de beber» (Jn 4,7). «Su sed material —nos dice san Juan Pablo II— es signo de una realidad mucho más profunda: manifiesta el ardiente deseo de que, tanto la mujer con la que habla como los demás samaritanos, se abran a la fe».

El Prefacio de la celebración eucarística de hoy nos hablará de que este diálogo termina con un trueque salvífico en donde el Señor, «(...) al pedir agua a la Samaritana, ya había infundido en ella la gracia de la fe, y si quiso estar sediento de la fe de aquella mujer, fue para encender en ella el fuego del amor divino».

Ese deseo salvador de Jesús vuelto “sed” es, hoy día también, “sed” de nuestra fe, de nuestra respuesta de fe ante tantas invitaciones cuaresmales a la conversión, al cambio, a reconciliarnos con Dios y los hermanos, a prepararnos lo mejor posible para recibir una nueva vida de resucitados en la Pascua que se nos acerca.

«Yo soy, el que te está hablando» (Jn 4,26): esta



directa y manifiesta confesión de Jesús acerca de su misión, cosa que no había hecho con nadie antes, muestra igualmente el amor de Dios que se hace más búsqueda del pecador y promesa de salvación que saciará abundantemente el deseo humano de la Vida verdadera. Es así que, más adelante en este mismo Evangelio,

Jesús proclamará: «Si alguno tiene sed, venga a mí, y beba el que crea en mí», como dice la Escritura: ‘De su seno correrán ríos de agua viva’» (Jn 7,37b-38). Por eso, tu compromiso es hoy salir de ti y decir a los hombres: «Venid a ver a un hombre que me ha dicho...» (Jn 4,29).
