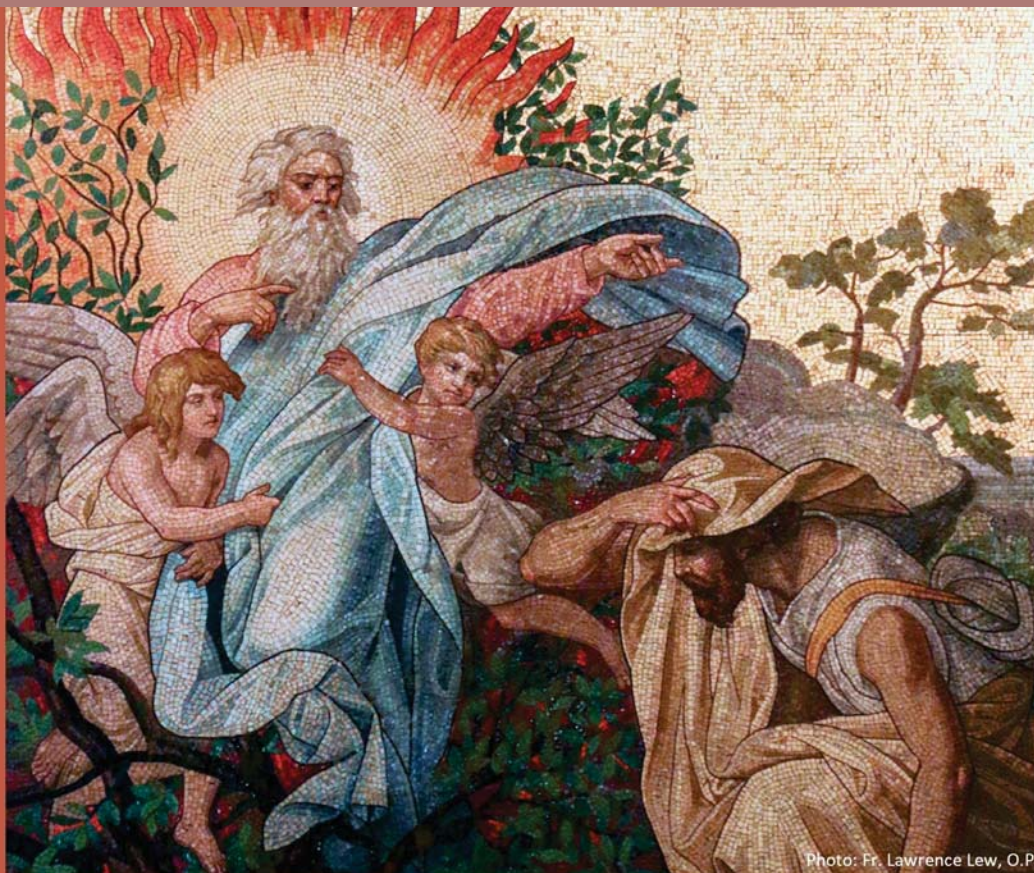

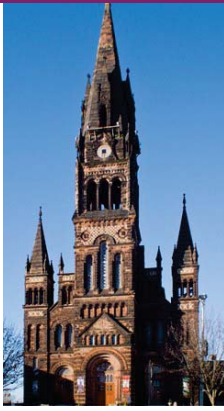

## Pastor's message

Dear brothers, Jesus said that the will of his Father is that we bear fruit and that our fruits remain forever, (cf. Jn 15:16) Today our Blessed Lord wants us to understand that this the time in our lives to bear fruit. Our blessed Lord has always interceded before our heavenly Father so that we bear fruit, even when because of our sins we bear bitter ones. In Jesus' parable, the owner of the fig tree (God) tells the humble worker (Jesus) to cut down and uproot that fig tree that bears no fruit (us) Jesus intercedes and asks the owner of the orchard to give him more time, that He would work so that it bears fruit next year. Jesus wants us to faithful to our promises made at baptism. He wants us to bear fruits so that we may be ready and present ourselves before God the Father, "Lord, you gave me five; here you go, I have gained another five talents over

them." (cfr. Mt 25:20) Our life on earth is for us to bear fruits of charity, goodness, mercy and love. This is what our heavenly Father expects of us. This Lenten season is that opportunity. Am I ready to be pruned and bear fruit? Jesus is with us!

**Feast of the Annunciation:** This coming Friday we make a little pause to rejoice and celebrate the solemnity of the Annunciation of the Lord. On this important celebration we, the priests, brother

Ruben, and the sisters are celebrating the 38th anniversary of our religious institute. The Institute of the Incarnate Word was founded on March 25, 1984 by Fr. Carlos Buena, IVE. All the members of the IVE strive to bring the Incarnation of Christ to all parts of the world. We are a missionary religious institute committed to enculturate the Gospel, that is to say, to extend the Incarnation

"to all men, in the whole man, and in all of the manifestations of man," (ive Constitutions) in accordance with the teachings of the



Magisterium of the Church. In order to effect this, we want to be rooted in Jesus Christ who has come in the flesh, and only in Christ, and always in Christ, and Christ in everything, and Christ in all, and all of Christ, because the Rock is Christ, "and no other foundation can anyone lay." (I Cor. 3:11). We want both to love and serve Jesus Christ; his Body (both His physical body in the Eucharist and His mystical body in the Church) as well as His Spirit, and to bring others to love and serve Him with us. It is a blessing that we are serving the diocese of Fall River, first serving in St. Killian parish from 1997 until the year of merging with St. Anthony of Padua in 2016 until now. ## Liturgy Corner

### LITURGICAL COLORS

**W**hite – Christmas Time and Easter Time; celebrations of the Lord (except of his Passion), of Mary, of the Angels, and of Saints who were not Martyrs; solemnities of the Most Holy Trinity, All Saints, the Nativity of St. John the Baptist, feasts of the Conversion of St. Paul, of the Chair of St. Peter, and of St. John; also permitted in the United States at Masses for the Dead.



**R**ed. The color red is used on Palm Sunday of the Lord's Passion and on Friday of Holy Week (Good Friday), on Pentecost Sunday, on celebrations of the Lord's Passion, on the "birthday" feast days of Apostles and Evangelists, and on celebrations of Martyr Saints.



**G**reen. The color green is used in the Offices and Masses of Ordinary Time. Worn on all days when no other color is prescribed. Masses for Various Needs, on the other hand, are celebrated in the color proper to the day or the time of year or in violet if they have a penitential character;



**V**iolet. The color violet or purple is used in Advent and Lent. It may also be worn in Offices and Masses for the Dead. Besides the color violet, the colors white or black may be used at funeral services and at other Offices and Masses for the Dead in the Dioceses of the United States of America.



**R**ose. The color rose may be used, where it is the practice, on Gaudete Sunday (Third Sunday of Advent) and on Laetare Sunday (Fourth Sunday of Lent). We don't have to confuse pink with rose color. The proper name is rose color.



**R**itual Masses are celebrated in their proper color, in white, or in a festive color; Votive Masses are celebrated in the color suited to the Mass itself or even in the color proper to the day or the time of the year. Black color is worn in Masses for the Dead.

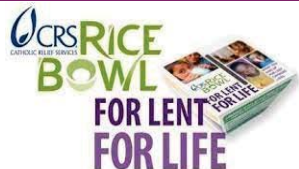

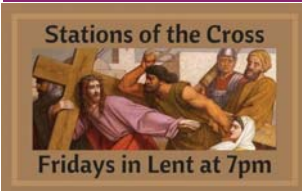

## Consecration

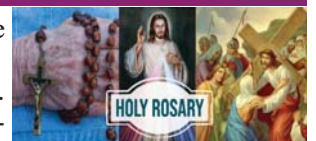

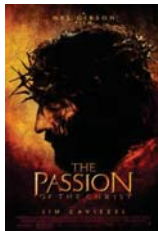

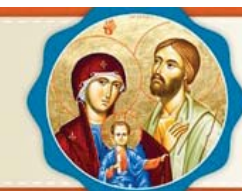
