



Pastor's message

Dear brothers and sisters, have you ever thought about having this relation with our blessed Lord, such as friend of Jesus.? So this is what today gospel talks about, "the one you love is ill" and then, Jesus himself, "Our friend Lazarus is asleep." Actually Jesus was friends of Mary, and Martha also. Many time the



Lord had to pass through their homes on his way to the north of Galilee, or to go to the holy city of Jerusalem. He was much most welcome in the house of these three siblings who consider themselves blessed to have such a friend. However, the death of Lazarus brought a original sin; 2nd, the actual sin against

terrible sadness in their homes, relatives and friends of the grieving sisters, Martha and Mary, and then, the message to the Lord to come to console us at this moment.

So the sisters sent word to him saying, "Master, the one you love is ill." Three things are offered here for our consideration, says St. Thomas Aguinas, First, that the friends of Christ are sometimes afflicted corporeally, For this is not a sign that one is not a friend of God, if he is ever afflicted bodily, as Eliphaz erroneously argued against Job: "And, sure enough, ruin never fell yet on the innocent; (Job 4:7) Therefore they (the sisters of Lazarus) say: Behold, he whom thou loves is sick. And in the Proverbs we read: "It is where he loves that he bestows correction, like a father whose son is dear to him." (3, 12).

Jesus came and found that he had been in the tomb four days (Jn 11:17). According to St. Augustine, Lazarus, dead four days, represents sinful man held back by the death of four sins: 1st, the natural law: 3rd. the actual sin against the written law; 4th, the actual sin against the law of the Gospel and of grace. Or, in other words, the



first day is the sin of the heart: "spare me the sight of your busy wickedness, of your wrong-doing take farewell" (Is 1:16). The second day is the sin of the mouth: "No base talk must cross your lips" (Eph 4:29) The third day is the sin of deed, of which Isaiah says: Cease to work wickedly (Is 1:16) The fourth day is the sin of perverse custom.

However, the Lord heals sometime the dead who have four days, that is, those who break the law of the Gospel, and those who are held back by the habit of

Liturgy Corner

O. Should I sit or Kneel after Com- a sacred encounter with the Living God, munion?

Q. What should one do after receiving Holy Communion? Should one sit or kneel in prayer?

A. We take our direction on all liturgical actions from what is called the General Instruction of the Roman Missal. Number 43 of that Instruction states: "... if appropriate, they may sit or kneel during the period of sacred silence after Communion."

This, of course, does not answer your question directly. What it means is that it is optional to sit or kneel at that time. It is more up to the established local custom, or the custom of the national bishops' conference, to make the normative determination for each location. Therefore, the best thing for you to do is to follow the custom of the local church under the direction of the priest. With that said, it seems most desirable to kneel at that time. Holy Communion is

and as a sign of your interior prayer, it is most desirable to enter into the most reverent posture possible. Some religious orders even lie prostrate at that moment.

However, even though it is legitimate to argue that kneeling is the best practice,





and even though this is the most common gesture in most territories, it is good for ever and ever. to act in uniformity with the local church Amen. and to follow the local custom, so as not to draw attention to yourself and to your personal prayer.

Most importantly, at that moment you should strive to tune everything else out and enter into deep prayer with God. If you do that, you can be assured that your Communion will be fruitful. Source of content: mycatholic.life

Mensaje del Padre Marcelo

"Yo soy la resurrección. El que cree en mí, aunque muera, vivirá"

Hoy, la Iglesia nos presenta un gran milagro: Jesús resucita a un difunto, muerto desde hacía varios días.



La resurrección de Lázaro es "tipo" de la de Cristo, que vamos a conmemorar próximamente. Jesús dice a Marta que Él es la «resurrección» y la vida (cf. Jn 11,25). A todos nos pregunta: «¿Crees esto?» (Jn 11,26). ¿Creemos que en el bautismo Dios nos ha regalado una nueva vida? Dice san Pablo que nosotros somos una nueva criatura (cf. 2Cor 5,17). Esta resurrección es el fundamento de nuestra esperanza, que se basa no en una utopía futura, incierta y falsa, sino en un hecho: «¡Es verdad! ¡El Señor ha resucitado!» (Lc 24,34).




Jesús manda: «Desatadlo y dejadle andar» (Jn 11,34). La redención nos ha liberado de las cadenas del pecado, que todos padecíamos. Decía el Papa León Magno: «Los errores fueron vencidos, las potestades sojuzgadas y el mundo ganó un nuevo comienzo. Porque si padecemos con Él, también reinaremos con Él (cf. Rom 8,17). Esta ganancia no sólo está preparada para los que en el nombre del Señor son triturados por los sin-dios. Pues todos los que sirven a Dios y viven en Él están crucificados en Cristo, y en Cristo conseguirán la corona».

Los cristianos estamos llamados, ya en esta tierra, a vivir esta nueva vida sobrenatural que nos hace capaces de dar crédito de nuestra suerte: ¡siempre dispuestos a dar respuesta a todo el que nos pida razón de nuestra esperanza! (cf. 1Pe 3,15). Es lógico que en estos días procuremos seguir de cerca a Jesús Maestro. Tradiciones como el Vía Crucis, la meditación de los Misterios del Rosario, los textos de los evangelios, todo... puede y debe sernos una ayuda.

Nuestra esperanza está también puesta en María, Madre de Jesucristo y nuestra Madre, que es a su vez un icono de la esperanza: al pié de la Cruz esperó contra toda esperanza y fue asociada a la obra de su Hijo.
