Pastor's message

Dear brothers and sisters, last Sunday during my homily I brought the message on the "Four Last Things" and mentioned just few words about what are the "last things," death, judgment, heaven, and hell. Today gospel talks about another article of our faith, that is "He will come again in glory." Indeed, we believe that the Lord will come at his sec-



ond coming. Our blessed Lord explain to those who asked "what sign will there be when all these things are about to happen?" and then Jesus goes on and explain the signs. In recent years we have witness all kind of natural disasters such as earthquakes, thienphen, hurricanes, mudslide, flood, and wildfire,

also riots in different countries, and innocents people being put to death; divisions in the holy mother Church, families, and in the society at large. The list go on and on. With all these we wonder, is this the end of the world near us? Or, Is God absent to the plight of the world? God is not absent to the troubles of the world. God is absent from the thoughts and decisions of many who have responsibilities in the world and are the cause of the trouble on it. Jesus prophesied that is necessary that all this must happen but it will not immediately be the end. These problems are not the cause of an immediate disaster or end of the world, however, these are part of the whole structure being shaken by the negligence of many in the world. God knows wells what is going on. Certainly, as people destine to live for ever we look forward to that second coming of Jesus where according to the Catechism of the Catholic Church affirms that the "Sacred Scripture calls this mysterious renewal, which will transform humanity and the world, "new heavens and a new earth." It will be the definitive realization of God's plan to bring under a sin-

gle head "all things in [Christ], things in heaven and things on earth." (CCC 1043) but first the world creation have to go to this purification. The first reading of today brings this "and the day that is coming will set them on fire, leaving them neither root nor branch, says the LORD of hosts. But for you who fear my name, there will arise the sun of justice with its healing rays." (Mt 3:19-20) therefore, the thoughts of eternity must lead us to focus on how to please the Lord in everything, leaving sin behind and resolutely work for bringing more people to our blessed Lord until we all are acquire the "new heavens and the new earth"

Liturgy Corner



TOPIC: Order of Christian Funerals

Q: I was visiting a friend's house recently and I admired a beautiful vase on her mantel. She told me it contained her grandmother's remains. I know that cremation is okay, but is -this really okay?

A. You correctly say that cremation is permitted now for Catholics, but you are also correct in feeling a bit uncomfortable about your friend's solution. Of course, her desire is to honor her grandmother, but our tradition is to remember our dear ones every time we gather at

the Eucharist. Taking the long view, we know that the vase will eventually pass into the hands of those who place no value on its contents. The Catechism of the Catholic Church reminds us that "the bodies of the dead must be treated with respect and charity, in the hope and faith of the Resurrection." This extends to cremated remains, which are to be buried, never scattered, nor retained or stored in a family home. Sadly, in the last year or so we have seen so many disasters around the world involving the search for the dead and their subsequent burial. The care and respect shown the dead by the rescuers remind us that burial of the dead is a "corporal work of mercy." As our funeral prayers affirm,

the grave remains a sign of hope even as it claims our mortal bodies. Some Catholic churches today include memorial "columbaria" from the Latin word for "dove cote," a wall with niches for the cremated remains. This is a happier solution than a fragile vase on a mantel: it designates a grave in a place where people gather in hope to pray. Our tradition, expressed in law and liturgy, seeks to honor the body, the temple of the Holy Spirit, with reverent burial.

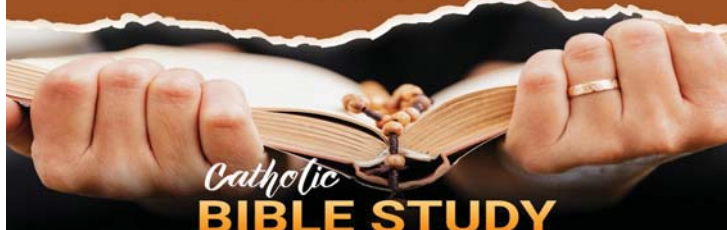

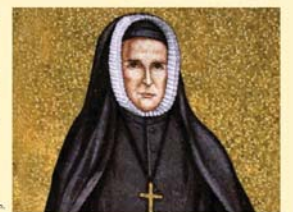

Growing up in a prosperous French family, Philippine joined the Visitation nuns, but returned to her family during the French Revolution. In 1804 she entered the Society of the Sacred Heart. After much preparation, she led a missionary journey to Missouri in 1818. She set up the first free school west of the Mississippi, Sacred Heart houses and Novitiate, and a school for Indians. Despite frontier hardships and ill health, she persevered in her early dream of serving Native Americans.

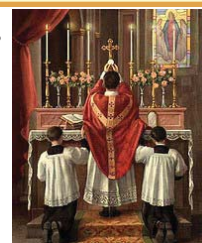

“Mirad, no os dejéis engañar”

Hoy, el Evangelio nos habla de la última venida del Hijo del hombre. Se acerca el final del año litúrgico y la Iglesia nos presenta la parusía, y al mismo tiempo quiere que pensemos en nuestras postrimerías: muerte, juicio, infierno o cielo. El fin de un viaje condiciona su realización. Si quieres ir al infierno, te podrás comportar de una manera determinada de acuerdo con el término de tu viaje. Si escoges el cielo, habrás de ser coherente con la Gloria que quieres conquistar. Siempre, libremente. Al infierno no va nadie por la fuerza; ni al cielo, tampoco. Dios es justo y da a cada uno lo que se ha ganado, ni más ni menos. No castiga ni premia arbitrariamente, movido por simpatías o antipatías. Respeta nuestra libertad.
