Pastor's message

My dear brothers and sisters, as we read and listen carefully the Sunday's Gospel reading, we realize that the Lord wants us to practice prayer with perseverance and faith. The widow that Jesus speaks



of is an example of perseverance in prayer. Many times we talk about storming heaven with our prayer; a metaphor which means, with all our might and

power. That is what we must do at all times, pray with our understanding, and will, and not only for ourselves, but also for all those who entrust themselves to our prayers, as we say at the end of each decade of the rosary, "especially to those most in need of your mercy." Prayer dear brothers is food for the soul and our communication with God, a God who listens to us, loves us and comforts us in all our needs. Sometimes, doubts arise as to whether or not God listens to my prayers, and this happens because many times the same problems and concerns continue; it would seem that all those requests that I put in God's hands are not heard. What can say is that God listens to all our prayers, sometimes He does not grant us immediately, because he wants us to grow in faith and perseverance. We must pray and abandon ourselves in his loving providence, saying that all our intentions be for his glory. That must be our main request. We may ask ourselves, do I pray like the widow? With simplicity and hope? With humility and confidence? Am I afraid, doubting, anxious in my prayers? Padre Pio tells us, "Pray, hope and don't wor-

ry. Worry is useless. Our Merciful Lord will listen to your prayer."

Liturgy Corner

Basic Forms of Prayer

Blessing: First, our prayers rise to the Father in Christ and by the power of the Holy Spirit. To bless God means that we offer up this worship and praise of Him, adoring Him and letting this blessing rise to the Father. Additionally, we are blessed by God in that His grace descends upon us as we bless Him.

Adoration: To adore God is to be in His presence with an interior solitude and love. It means we are not only aware of God's divine presence intellectually but are also attentive to Him with all the powers of our soul. Our whole being is moved with love toward God and with an acknowledgment of His divinity, majesty and glory.

Petition: First of all, our petition is for mercy and forgiveness. We always need to pray that prayer. From there, we must continually petition God for every good thing. But we must be careful to understand this correctly! Often, it is easy to simply pray for what WE think

is good. True petition seeks only the fulfillment of the Kingdom of God on earth. It seeks the will of God and only the will of God. The ultimate



petition to God is, "Thy Kingdom come, Thy will be done."

Intercession: We are called to intercede for the needs of all people. Our prayers are efficacious. Why? Because God

desires to use us as mediators for others. He uses the saints, especially our Blessed Mother, but also wants to use us as intercessors for the needs of others. This reveals the great communion we share with all Christians, in that our bond with them, in Christ, enables us to be instruments of grace for others through our prayers.

Thanksgiving: All is a gift, and all is grace. This should move us to an attitude of thanksgiving. Thanksgiving is an appropriate response to God in all that He has done for us.

Praise: Closely associated with thanksgiving, praise of God is given because God is God and is worthy of all praise. Praise is given not so much because of what God has done for us; rather, it is given simply because God is worthy of praise. The Psalms, especially, highlight the form of praise that should be given to God.

Mensaje del Párroco

«Es preciso orar siempre sin desfallecer»

Hoy, Jesús nos recuerda que «es preciso orar siempre sin desfallecer» (Lc 18,1). Enseña con sus obras y con las palabras. San Lucas se nos presenta como el evangelista de la oración de Jesús. Efectivamente, en algunas de las escenas de la vida del Señor, que los autores inspirados de la Escritura Santa nos transmiten, es únicamente Lucas quien nos lo muestra rezando.



En el Bautismo en el Jordán, en la elección de los Doce y en la Transfiguración. Cuando un discípulo le pidió «Señor, enséñanos a orar» (Lc 11,1), de sus labios salió el Padrenuestro. Cuando anuncia las negaciones a Pedro: «Yo he rogado por ti, para que tu fe no desfallezca» (Lc 22,32). En la crucifixión: «Padre, perdónales, porque no saben lo que hacen» (Lc 23,34). Cuando muere en la Cruz: «Padre, en tus manos pongo mi espíritu», del Salmo 31. El Señor mismo es modelo de la oración de petición, especialmente en Getsemaní, según la descripción de todos los evangelistas.

—Puedo ir concretando cómo elevaré el corazón a Dios en las distintas actividades, porque no es lo mismo hacer un trabajo intelectual que manual; estar en la iglesia que en el campo de deportes o en casa; conducir por la ciudad que por la autopista; no es lo mismo la oración de petición que el agradecimiento; o la adoración que pedir perdón; de buena mañana que cuando llevamos todo el cansancio del día. San Josemaría Escrivá nos da una receta para la oración de petición: «Más consigue aquél que importuna más de cerca... Por tanto, acércate a Dios: esfuérzate por ser santo».

Santa María es modelo de oración, también de petición. En Caná de Galilea es capaz de avanzar la hora de Jesús, la hora de los milagros, con su petición, llena de amor por aquellos esposos y llena de confianza en su Hijo.

Que La Virgen Santísima interceda por cada uno de nosotros junto a su hijo Jesus.
