


mercy. This should lead us to pray for others, to be intercessors before heaven for others in need.

## Liturgy Corner

### Light a Candle

November is coming up and by catholic it is the month dedicated to pray for the souls in purgatory. Yes, the forgotten poor souls in purgatory. They are poor because they cannot merits by themselves. They need our prayers and act of mercy.

During November many Catholics visit a church or cemetery to pray for the holy souls in purgatory, and the Church encourages this custom by attaching a "plenary indulgence" to such prayers for the faithful departed. This indulgence means that through our prayers we can help departed souls complete their preparation for heavenly life.

This is what you have to do to gain the indulge for the souls in purgatory:

visiting a church or an oratory and reciting an *Our Father* and the *Creed*, which can be done on any day in November. A plenary indulgence remits all tem-

poral punishment due to sin. It must always be accompanied by a full detachment from sin.

A Catholic who wishes to obtain a plenary indulgence must also fulfill the ordinary conditions of an indulgence, which are sacramental confession, reception of the Eucharist, and prayer for the pope's intentions.

The Catechism of the Catholic Church states in paragraph 1032 the following,

"This teaching is also based on the practice of prayer for the dead, already mentioned in Sacred Scripture: "Therefore [Judas Maccabeus] made atonement for the dead, that they might be delivered from their sin." From the beginning the Church has honored the memory of the dead and offered prayers in suffrage for them, above all the Eucharistic sacrifice, so that,

thus purified, they may attain the beatific vision of God. The Church also commends almsgiving, indulgences, and works of penance undertaken on behalf of the dead."

In St. Anthony's Parish let us pray during this month of November the our Father and Creed. Also you may light a candle in remembrance of the soul you want to pray.



## Mensaje del Párroco

«¡Oh Dios! ¡Ten compasión de mí...»

Hoy leemos con atención y novedad el Evangelio de san Lucas. Una parábola dirigida a nuestros corazones. Unas palabras de vida para desvelar nuestra autenticidad humana y cristiana, que se fundamenta en la humildad de sabernos pecadores («¡Oh Dios! ¡Ten compasión de mí, que soy pecador!»: Lc 18,13), y en la misericordia y bondad de nuestro Dios («Todo el que se ensalce, será humillado; y el que se humille, será ensalzado»: Lc 18,14).



La autenticidad es, ¡hoy más que nunca!, una necesidad para descubrirnos a nosotros mismos y resaltar la realidad liberadora de Dios en nuestras vidas y en nuestra sociedad. Es la actitud adecuada para que la Verdad de nuestra fe llegue, con toda su fuerza, al hombre y a la mujer de ahora. Tres ejes vertebran a esta autenticidad evangélica: la firmeza, el amor y la sensatez (cf. 2Tim 1,7).

La firmeza, para conocer la Palabra de Dios y mantenerla en nuestras vidas, a pesar de las dificultades. Especialmente en nuestros días, hay que poner atención en este punto, porque hay mucho auto-engañó en el ambiente que nos rodea. San Vicente de Lerins nos advertía: «Apenas comienza a extenderse la podredumbre de un nuevo error y éste, para justificarse, se apodera de algunos versículos de la Escritura, que además interpreta con falsedad y fraude».



El amor, para mirar con ojos de ternura —es decir, con la mirada de Dios— a la persona o al acontecimiento que tenemos delante. San Juan Pablo II nos anima a «promover una espiritualidad de la comunión», que —entre otras cosas— significa «una mirada del corazón sobre todo hacia el misterio de la Trinidad que habita en nosotros, y cuya luz ha de ser reconocida también en el rostro de los hermanos que están a nuestro lado».

Y, finalmente, sensatez, para transmitir esta Verdad con el lenguaje de hoy, encarnando realmente la Palabra de Dios en nuestra vida: «Crearán a nuestras obras más que a cualquier otro discurso» (San Juan Crisóstomo).

Que Dios te lo bendiga.
