

## Pastor's message

My dear brothers and sisters, the biblical passages of this twenty eighth Sunday in the ordinary time, invites us to explore on certain key situations to.... Naaman was commander of the Syrian army well esteemed by the king of Syria. Naaman has leprosy. His wife had a little girl that said if only the master will go to see the prophet of Israel he would be cured. By the prescription of this prophet (Elisha) he was cleaned by bathing in the Jordan River. In thanksgiving for this miracle, he gave the prophet several gift offering and stop worshipping false gods in Syria. In the gospel our blessed Lord met ten lepers who ask the Lord for heal, "Jesus, Master! Have pity on us!" These men show the importance and necessity to go to our blessed Lord for healing. That should be our prayer, "have pity on us" St. Bernard says that, "In our days you see



many people who pray, but, unfortunately, there are not many who realize what they owe to God and give thanks... «Haven't the ten been cleansed? the other nine, where are they? I think you remember that it is with these words that the Lord lamented the ingratitude of the other nine lepers. We read that they knew how to "pray, beg, ask" because they raised their voices to exclaim: "Jesus, son of David, have mercy on us". But they lacked a fourth thing, which is what Saint Paul calls for: "thanksgiving" (1Tm 2, 1), because they did not return and did not give thanks to God." First of all we are clean of the leprosy of our sin, in the sacrament of baptism. Through that water that was touched by the body of our blessed Lord in the Jordan river, we are clean of our original sin. The sin that led us out of paradise. Through the sacrament of confession or reconciliation we

are once again clean of our mortal sins committed by our frail humanity. In this sacrament when the penitent goes to confession, he/she considers one who is in need of healing. Today we have the certainty that our sins are forgiving because the priest says so, "I absolve you from your sins... your sins are forgiven, go in peace." Our thanksgiving should be similar to that of Naaman and the foreigner leper, who the former came back to thank the prophet with gifts for sacrifice in thanksgiving, and the latter throwing at the feet of Jesus and thank him. The Mass is the best act of thanksgiving we can render to our heavenly Father. Let us make sure that every Sunday we should be here at the foot of the Altar to give thanks to God for all the good things he has given us, most especially for forgiving and cleansing of our sins. Happy Sunday to everyone!


## Liturgy Corner

### Q. Rosaries in the Rear View Mirror

Q. I've seen people hang rosaries over the rear view mirrors in their cars and a few of them wear them around their necks. Is it OK to do that?

A. First of all, let me give a simple answer and say that I think these practices are fine. I've seen many rosaries hanging from rear view mirrors of people who are quite devout and love our Lord and His Blessed Mother. For them I believe it is a way of letting their love for Mary show forth for all to see. I think the same would be said for those who have

worn them around the neck. So I think that if someone chooses to do either of these practices they are most likely doing it out of a devotion to and love for our Blessed Mother. Personally I do not hang the rosary from my mirror or wear it around my neck but I always have it



in my pocket. And at night I sleep with it wrapped around my wrist. I suppose that keeping the rosary close to us is similar to wearing a cross or scapular or like hanging a sacred picture in our room. Rosaries are blessed objects so, for that reason, are good to have around. With that said I think it must also be said that the Rosary is, first and foremost, an instrument of prayer. And I suggest to you that it is one of the best prayers we can pray. Rather than explain the Rosary in my words, allow me to offer you some of my favorite quotes from the great saints regarding the rosary.





## Mensaje del Párroco

¡Jesús, Maestro, ¡ten compasión de nosotros!

Hoy podemos comprobar, ¡una vez más!, cómo nuestra actitud de fe puede remover el corazón de Jesucristo. El hecho es que unos leprosos, venciendo la reprobación social que sufrían los que tenían la lepra y con una buena dosis de audacia, se acercan a Jesús y —podríamos decir entre comillas— le obligan con su confiada petición: «¡Jesús, Maestro, ¡ten compasión de nosotros!» (Lc 17,13).



La respuesta es inmediata y fulminante: «Id y presentaos a los sacerdotes» (Lc 17,14). Él, que es el Señor, muestra su poder, ya que «mientras iban, quedaron limpios» (Lc 17,14).

Esto nos muestra que la medida de los milagros de Cristo es, justamente, la medida de nuestra fe y confianza en Dios. ¿Qué hemos de hacer nosotros —pobres criaturas— ante Dios, sino

confiar en Él? Pero con una fe operativa, que nos mueve a obedecer las indicaciones de Dios. Basta un mínimo de sentido común para entender que «nada es demasiado difícil de creer

tocando a Aquel para quien nada es demasiado difícil de hacer (Beato J. H. Newman). Si no vemos más milagros es porque “obligamos” poco al Señor con nuestra falta de confianza y de obediencia a su voluntad. Como dijo san Juan



15. Mientras iban quedaron sanos. Uno de ellos, al verse sano, volvió de inmediato alabando a Dios en alta voz, 16. y se echó a los pies de Jesús con el rostro en tierra, dándole las gracias. Era un samaritano.

Crisóstomo, «un poco de fe puede mucho». Y, como coronación de la confianza en Dios, llega el desbordamiento de la alegría y del agradecimiento: en efecto, «uno de ellos, viéndose curado, se volvió glorificando a Dios en alta voz; y postrándose rostro en tierra a los pies de Jesús, le daba gracias» (Lc 17,15-16).

Pero..., ¡qué lástima! De diez beneficiarios de aquel gran milagro, sólo regresó uno. ¡Qué ingratos somos cuando olvidamos con tanta facilidad que todo nos viene de Dios y que a él todo lo debemos! Hagamos el propósito de obligarle mostrándonos confiados en Dios y agradecidos a Él.
