

Cape Peninsula Tour: Cape Point + Penguins + Chapman's Peak

Summary: Discover the beauty of the Cape Peninsula, including the most south-westerly point of the African continent at Cape Point, the penguin colony at Boulders Beach, and dramatic Chapman's Peak Drive.



Type: Full Day Guided Tour // 08:30 – 17:30

Details:

The day will start with an 08:30 am pick-up at your central Cape Town hotel. Our first stop is the quirky village of Kalk Bay, known for its artistic charm and colourful harbour.

Our next stop is the famous Boulders Beach Penguin Colony, where you'll have the chance to observe the African penguins up close. You'll also have time for a swim — the waters of False Bay are slightly warmer, and the beach is beautifully sheltered.

We then continue into the Cape Point Nature Reserve, heading first to Cape Point and its iconic lighthouse for sweeping views over the rugged coastline. Afterwards, we visit the Cape of Good Hope, where you'll enjoy a scenic break with coffee or tea and a short orientation of this remarkable region.

Leaving the reserve, we drive to Scarborough for a relaxed lunch in this peaceful coastal village.

After lunch, we follow the spectacular Chapman's Peak Drive, one of the most scenic coastal roads in the world, overlooking Long Beach and passing through Noordhoek and Kommetjie.

The journey continues via Hout Bay and Camps Bay, with several superb lookout points along the way for photos. Expect to return to your Cape Town hotel around 17:30.
