

Cape Peninsula Tour: Cape Point + Penguins + Chapmans Peak

Summary: Discover the beauty of the Cape Peninsula, including the most south-westerly point of the African continent at Cape Point, the penguin colony at Boulders Beach, and dramatic Chapmans Peak Drive.



Type: Full Day Guided Tour // 08:30 – 17:30

Details:

The day will start with an 08:30 am pick-up at your central Cape Town hotel. Our first stop is the quirky village of Kalk Bay, known for its artistic charm and colourful harbour.

From Kalk Bay, we continue towards the Cape Point Nature Reserve. Once inside the reserve, we make our way to the Cape of Good Hope for a scenic stop and a coffee/tea break, along with a short orientation of this remarkable region. Afterwards, we head up to Cape Point and its iconic lighthouse, where sweeping views over False Bay and the surrounding coastline await.

Leaving the reserve, we continue to the coastal town of Simon's Town for a lunch stop.

Our next highlight is Boulders Beach, home to the famous African penguin colony. Here, you'll have a chance to view the incredible Penguins, and you will have an opportunity for a swim. The water in False Bay is slightly warmer, and there is a beautiful swimming beach :-)

After some quality time at the penguins, we drive along the spectacular Chapman's Peak Drive, overlooking Long Beach and passing through Noordhoek and Kommetjie. From there it is onwards via Hout Bay and back to Cape Town via Camps Bay, taking in some superb lookout points en route to take photos. Expect to return to your hotel around 17:30.
