# Ash Wednesday

Lent begins this week on Ash Wednesday, March 5, a day of Fast and Abstinence.

Masses will be celebrated at:  
8:00 a.m., 11:00 a.m. (school children will attend),  
& 7:00 p.m.  
Ashes will be distributed during the Mass.

## LENTEN REGULATIONS:


The following regulations are in place for Abstaining and Fasting during Lent:

**ABSTINENCE:** Everyone fourteen years of age and older is bound to abstain from meat on *ASH WEDNESDAY*, the *FRIDAYS of Lent* and *GOOD FRIDAY*.

**FAST:** Everyone eighteen years of age and older but under the age of sixty is also bound to fast on *ASH WEDNESDAY* and *GOOD FRIDAY*.

On these two days, the law of fast allows only one full meal a day, but does not prohibit taking some food during the day, so long as this does not constitute another full meal. Drinking liquids during the day is permitted.

When health or ability to work would be seriously affected, the law does not oblige. In doubt concerning fast or abstinence, a priest assigned to pastoral ministry or confessor should be consulted. In the spirit of penance, the faithful should not lightly excuse themselves from this obligation.
