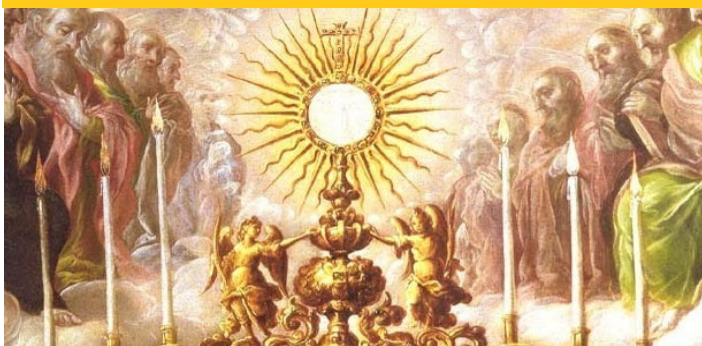

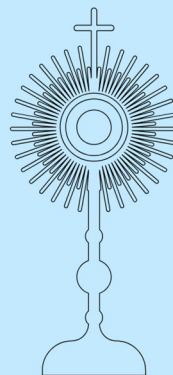

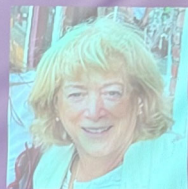
Women's Cursillo Weekend: October 9-12, 2025
