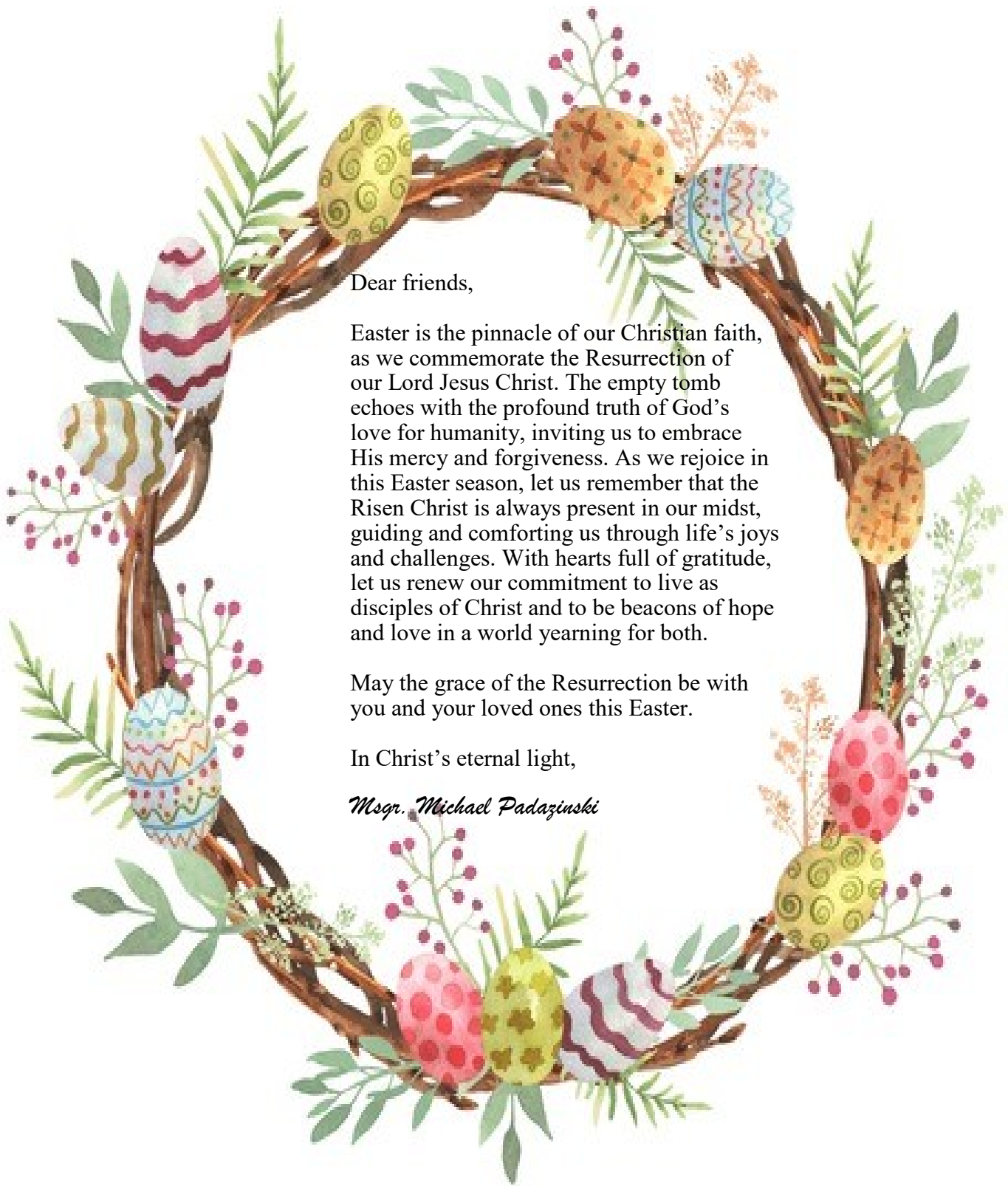

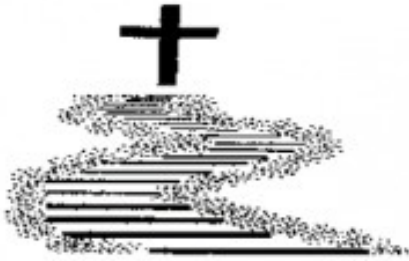
May the grace of the Resurrection be with you and your loved ones this Easter.

Great news for St. Patrick Parish

Archbishop Cordileone, recognizing the wonderful and faith-filled parish that is here, has decided that upon his Ordination to the transitional diaconate in May, Jimmy Velasco will be assigned to our parish. Jimmy Velasco is a seminarian for the Archdiocese of San Francisco preparing to conclude his priestly formation at St. Patrick Seminary in Menlo Park, CA. He is originally from San Francisco and as a native to the city he attended School of the Epiphany and Archbishop Riordan High School. His home parish is the Church of the Epiphany. His family resides in San Francisco and he has one older brother. Jimmy entered the seminary in 2018 for the Archdiocese and was sent to Bishop White College Seminary in Spokane, WA for three years. After graduating in 2021, he returned home to St. Patrick Seminary to study theology. Now in his final semester, he is anticipating his ordination as a transitional deacon this coming May and as a priest later this year in December.
