The first priority is food. If St. Vincent de Paul volunteers visiting a new individual or family determine that that family is lacking food, they immediately give them grocery cards. Each month our conference assesses the food needs of our neighbors currently seeking help and hand deliver cards to all those needing this assistance.

Then we assess their housing needs. It is the St. Patrick's SVDP Conference's commission, reason for being, to keep all those in our geographic area from slipping into homelessness. To that end, we pay rent, utilities, car repair and registration, medical bills, whatever is needed in a moment of crisis to keep our neighbors housed.

This support is possible only because of you, the most incredibly generous group of people, our parishioners who have faithfully supported this work for years. That opportunity for giving is now upon us. On May 30 and 31, there will be a second collection at St. Patrick's for the work of our parish SVDP Conference. This is the second of only four fifth Sundays this year. We encourage you to donate whatever you can and are very grateful for your making our outreach possible and effective.
