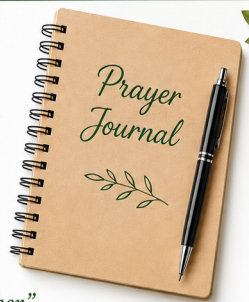

Each month our conference assesses the food needs of our neighbors currently seeking help and hand deliver cards to all those needing this assistance.

Then we assess their housing needs. It is the St. Patrick's SVDP Conference's commission, reason for being, to keep all those in our geographic area from slipping into homelessness. To that end, we pay rent, utilities, car repair and registration, medical bills, whatever is needed in a moment of crisis to keep our neighbors housed.

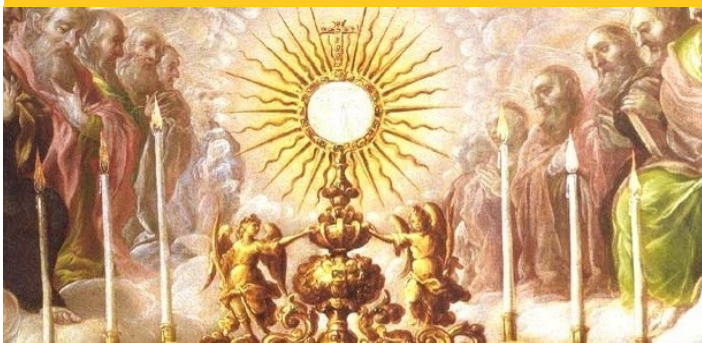
