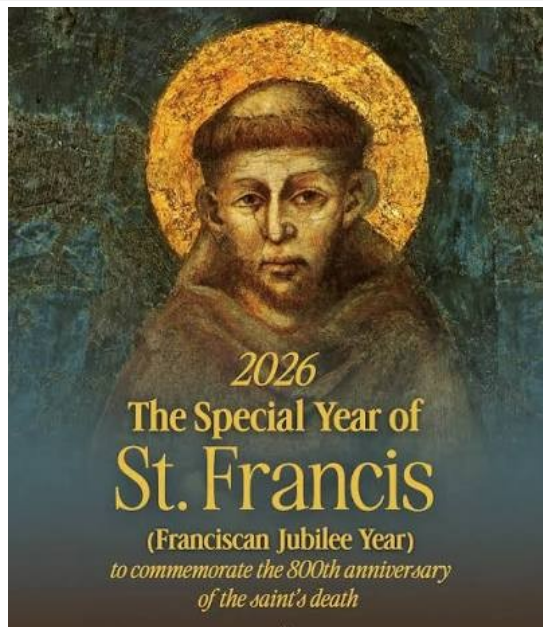

A Special Year of Saint Francis of Assisi: Pilgrimage Sites

In honor of this special year of the occasion of the 800th anniversary of the Transitus (death) of Saint Francis, Archbishop Cordileone has designated several locations where the faithful may make a pilgrimage and pray devoutly to fulfill the conditions for receiving a plenary indulgence*:

National Shrine of Saint Francis of Assisi
Mission Dolores Church
St. Francis of Assisi Catholic Church East Palo Alto
Mission San Rafael
Cathedral of St. Mary of the Assumption

* To gain a plenary indulgence, in addition to excluding all attachment to sin, even venial sin, it is necessary to perform a prescribed work designated by the Church (such as praying the stations of the cross in a church or visiting one of the designated pilgrimage sites) and fulfill the following three conditions: sacramental confession, Eucharistic Communion, and prayer for the intentions of the Pope.

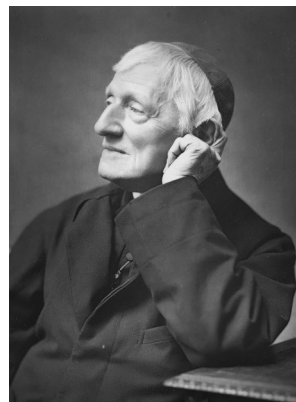
