Eucharistic Ministers bring Communion to those who are unable to attend Mass. Contact the Parish Office for more information.

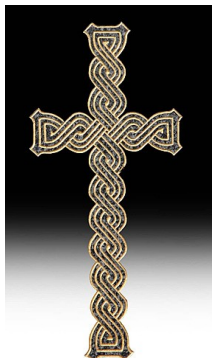
SACRAMENT OF ANOINTING OF THE SICK
