THE SOLEMNITY OF THE EPIPHANY OF THE LORD

Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

The readings for the Epiphany of the Lord speak about God revealing His saving presence to the whole world, inviting us to recognize Jesus as Lord and to respond with faith, joy and worship.

In the First reading from the book of Isaiah, we hear a call to rise and shine for the light of God has come to illuminate the darkness. This light is not just for a select few but is meant for all; a promise that all nations will come to know the glory of the Lord. The overwhelming grace of this prophecy reminds us that God's grace is universal, reaching beyond cultural and geographical boundaries. It reminds us that true leadership is rooted in serving others, a reflection of Christ's kingship, which was first revealed to the humble shepherds and later to the esteemed Magi.

In the Gospel of Mathew, we witness the actual event of the Magi's visit. They are seekers of truth, following a star to find the light of the world. That journey is one of faith, humility and openness, a model for us all. When they came to Jesus, they presented their gifts of gold, frankincense and myrrh, symbolizing His kingship, divinity and the suffering He would endure.

The Epiphany invites us to reflect on our own journey towards Christ. Are we willing to accept the light that shines in our own darkness? Are we ready to share this light with others, inviting them to join us in worship? Obedience to God leads to transformation. The Magi left for their country by another road symbolizes a changed life after encountering Christ.
