FIFTH SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME

Dear Brothers and Sisters,

In the Gospel of Matthew, today, Jesus refers to his disciples as "the salt of the earth and the light of the world." Salt enhances flavor and preserves what is good, while the light penetrates darkness and reveals truth. We are not meant to hide our faith but to let it shine brightly, influencing the world for good. For us Christians, God is our light from within. The Holy Spirit, whom we receive at baptism, is the source of both of our love and of our light. It is He who turns us into a flaming torch that we may enlighten those around us. The moment we lose Him, we turn into darkness.

Salt in the ancient world was essential for preservation, flavoring and sometimes purification. Light symbolized divine presence, revelation, and life. Just as salt acts as a preservative, disciples are called to prevent moral and spiritual decline. Salt gives flavor to the food, in the same way, the disciples are to give meaning and direction to human life. A Christian ought to make his own life tasty that is meaningful and help those around him to give true meaning to their lives. A life without faith is like food without salt. It has no taste, no meaning. The warning is stark: discipleship that loses its distinctive character becomes useless. Faith must turn the life of a Christian into a shining light. Salt works quietly and light works naturally. A Christian perceives God's plan of love for him and for all people and does his best to help those around him to discover them and to walk towards God.
