THE MOST HOLY TRINITY

Dear Brothers and Sisters,

Today, we gather to celebrate the solemnity of the Most Holy Trinity, a mystery at the very heart of our faith. The Readings for the Trinity Sunday year A, invite us to reflect on the nature of God as relational and loving, revealing Himself in a profound way as Father, Son and Holy Spirit. God is not a solitary being enthroned far away in the heavens, but an eternal community of self- giving love- Father, Son and Holy Spirit- one God in three divine persons.

In the First Reading from Exodus, we see God revealing Himself to Moses, as compassionate, gracious, slow to anger and abounding in steadfast love. The foundational understanding of God emphasizes His desire to relationship with His people. Just as Moses sought to God intimately, we too are called into this ongoing relationship.

In Holy Communion, we receive the Son, given by the Father, and through the power of the Holy Spirit. In this small white host, the three divine persons are present. Let us grow in closer communion with Holy Trinity, by remaining united with everyone we meet in our daily lives.

In John's Gospel, we hear perhaps one of the most well-known verses, 'for God so loved the world that He gave His only Son'. Here we see the depth of the Father's love manifested in the sacrifice of His Son. This act of love is the ultimate expression of the Trinity, where the Father, Son, and the Holy Spirit work in unison for our salvation. Jesus did not come to condemn but to save, offering us the light of life.
