ELEVENTH SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME

Dear Brothers and Sisters,

The Readings for the 11th Sunday Ordinary Time, year A, remind us of the profound relationship between God and His people: a relationship marked by love, mercy and a call to serve.

In today's First Reading from the book of Exodus, we hear about God's covenant with the Israelites. He calls them to be His treasured possession, a kingdom of priests and a holy nation. This invitation is not just for the sake of privilege but for mission. God desires that His people reflect His holiness and share His love with the world. This theme resonates deeply in our own lives, as we are also called in to a relationship with God and sent forth to bear witness to His goodness. He is a loving creator who desires a personal connection with each of us. 'I bore you on eagles' wings, this metaphor communicates protection, care, strength, a divine initiative.

In the Gospel of Matthew, we see Jesus moved by compassion as He looks upon the crowds, distressed and dejected. He then sends His disciples out empowering them to heal, proclaim Good News, and serve those in need. Jesus' action reminds us that our faith is not merely a personal journey but a communal mission. We, too, are called to respond to the world's needs with compassion and action.
