TWELFTH SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME

Dear Brothers and Sisters,

This Sunday's gospel invites us to live with a courage rooted not in ourselves, but in God's faithfulness. Jesus' words today are direct, but they are not meant to frighten us. They are meant to awaken us. "Everyone who acknowledges me before others, I will acknowledge before my heavenly Father. But whoever denies me before others, I will deny before my heavenly Father."

He reminds us that faith is not simply a private comfort — it is a relationship meant to be lived openly, gently, and courageously. To acknowledge Christ is not about dramatic speeches or public displays. It is about the quiet, steady choices that reveal who we belong to, choosing honesty over convenience, compassion over indifference, forgiveness over resentment, and truth over fear. These daily acts become our witness.

The warning about "denying" Him is not a threat but a reminder of how easily fear can silence our faith. Jesus invites us to trust that when we stand with Him — even imperfectly — He stands with us before the Father. Our fidelity, however small, is seen and cherished.

This week, may we live our faith with humble confidence, letting our words and actions say clearly: I belong to Christ.

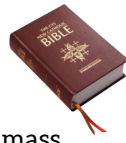

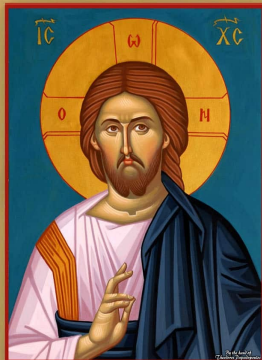
