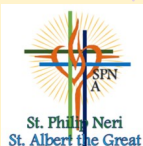

THE MOST HOLY BODY AND BLOOD OF CHRIST ~ CORPUS CHRISTI JUNE 22, 2025



Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

Today as we celebrate the solemnity of the Most Holy and Blood of Christ, we are invited to reflect on the profound mystery of the Eucharist, its deep significance and the transformative power it holds for both our personal lives and our shared journey of faith.

In the First reading from the book of Genesis, we encounter Melchizedek, the king of Salem who offered bread and wine to Abraham. This moment foreshadows the Eucharist, where bread and wine become the body and blood of Christ. Melchizedek's act of blessing signifies that God is intimately involved in our earthly journey, nourishing us not only physically but also spiritually.

In the Gospel, we have the miraculous feeding of the crowd of five thousand men could be understood as a type or prefiguring of Jesus' gift of the eucharistic bread that would spiritually nourish those who believed in Him. The 'taking, breaking and giving' of the loaves anticipated the taking of Jesus in the garden, the breaking of His body during His passion and Jesus' giving of Himself as a sacrifice for the sins of humankind. The description of the miracles also points out the disciple's role in the miraculous feeding of the multitude. Only after they gave Him five loaves and two fish, Jesus bless, break and give it back to them to distribute to the hungry crowd. This shows us that in our human limitations, God's abundance is revealed. In our sharing of this meal, we become vessels of God's love, called to feed the hungry and care for those in need.
