THIRTEENTH SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME

Dear Brothers and Sisters,

The Readings for the thirteenth Sunday in ordinary time year A, invite us to grow ever deeper in our relationship with God and to express that relationship through love, compassion and respect for those around us.

In the First Reading from the second book of Kings, we witness the profound hospitality of the Shunammite woman who welcomes the prophet Elisha into her home. In her generosity, she not only provides a meal but also arranges a space for him, demonstrating that true hospitality goes beyond mere provision; it is a recognition of the sacredness of the other. In her kindness, she receives a great blessing – in this case, the promise of a son. Later when the child died of a stroke, Elisha restored him back to life, thus multiplying the joy of the mother a hundred-fold. This reminds us that when we open our lives to others, we may also invite divine blessings on our own. In our acts of kindness and hospitality, we reflect God's unwavering love and faithfulness. Each act, no matter how small, can be a testament to God's ongoing love in the world.

In the Gospel, Jesus establishes the radical nature of discipleship. 'Whoever loves a father or mother more than me is not worthy of me'. This strong language challenges us to evaluate our priorities and the extent of our commitment to the Gospel. It is a call to love and serve generously, even when it requires a lot of sacrifices. Jesus demands total service, complete allegiance. We should be ready to give up even our deepest loves, family, or even life, when these prevent us from following Him.
