SAINTS PETER AND PAUL, APOSTLES **JUNE 29, 2025**

Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

Today, the Church celebrates two great pillars of our faith: Saint Peter and Saint Paul. Though very different in personality and background, they shared a deep love for Christ, unwavering faith, and the courage to proclaim the Gospel, even to the point of martyrdom.

Both had their weakness, but Christ still chose them. Their life teaches us that God works through our weakness when we place our trust in Him. Peter's humility and faith made him the solid foundation of the Church. Paul's words in the second reading reveal his heart: "I have fought the good fight, I have finished the race, I have kept the faith." Despite trials, imprisonment, and suffering, Paul never gave up on his mission.

Though Peter and Paul were different they shared the same faith, the same mission, and ultimately, the same martyrdom for Christ. Their unity reminds us that the Church is built not on uniformity, but on a shared commitment to Christ. Their courage calls us to stand firm in our faith, especially in a world that often opposes Gospel values. *What Can We Learn?*

God uses the imperfect. Our past mistakes do not define our future when we open our hearts to God's grace. Faith requires courage. The Church is a mission. Like Peter, we are called to be living witnesses of faith. Like Paul, we are sent to share the Gospel wherever God places us.

Today, let us honor Saints Peter and Paul by recommitting ourselves to Christ: Do I boldly proclaim my faith like Peter? Am I willing to carry the Gospel to others like Paul? Do I allow God's grace to work through my weaknesses?

May their example inspire us to stand strong, to remain united in faith, and to build the Church with courage and love.

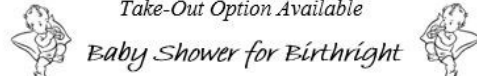
