The Readings for the 14th Sunday in ordinary time Year C, invite us to reflect on the theme of joy and the mission entrusted to us as followers of Christ.

The First Reading is from the last chapter of the book of Prophet Isaiah; we hear the beautiful imagery of God nurturing His people. The image of a mother nurturing her children reflects the deep love and compassion God has for His people. 'Rejoice with Jerusalem' we are told, highlighting that joy is not just a personal experience but a communal one. God brings comfort and abundance, and we are called to share in that joy as His children.

In the Gospel of Luke, Jesus sends out the seventy-two disciples, representing the whole world, equipping them with a mission. He instructs them to proclaim peace and to heal the sick. Jesus demands radical trust in God's providence and the hospitality of others. Their joy upon returning is a testament to the effectiveness of their mission. They not only preached the Good News but also experienced the power of God at work through them. Jesus reminded them, and us today, that our authority and joy come from our relationship with Him.

Are we joyful followers filled with gratitude for what God has done in our lives? Are we willing to share in the struggles of others, demonstrating that our faith is alive and actionable?
