SIXTEENTH SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME JULY 20, 2025

Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

The readings for the 16th Sunday in ordinary time, Year C, invite us into a deeper understanding of hospitality and the call to prioritize what truly matters.

In our first reading from Genesis, we witness Abraham's encounter with three visitors. With remarkable generosity, he offers them food and shelter, exemplifying true hospitality. This ancient practice reveals not just a cultural norm but a profound spiritual reality: the recognition that in serving others, we often encounter God. Abraham's hospitality is not merely about food and drink. It is rooted in a desire to welcome the divine presence into his home. For that, Abraham is rewarded with a son in the following year, to fulfill God's promise.

In today's gospel, we meet Martha and Mary. Martha busies herself with many tasks, while Mary sits at the feet, listening to His words. Martha, in her busyness, becomes distracted, anxious and even frustrated with her sister. Martha finally speaks up, overwhelmed, unappreciated, wanting help. Jesus gently admonishes Martha, highlighting that while serving is valuable, being present to the Lord and attentive to His voice is paramount. 'Mary has chosen the better part', her choice is not a rejection of service but a prioritization. Listening to Jesus is the foundation of discipleship. Martha and Mary teach us the importance of both action and contemplation. Jesus did not say that the service is bad, but He lovingly invites Martha to see what truly matters. As Christians, we are called to balance our acts of service with attentive listening to God's word.
