TWENTY-FIRST SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME AUGUST 24, 2025

Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

In today's Gospel, someone asks Jesus a question that perhaps we all have wondered: "Lord, will only a few people be saved?" Instead of giving statistics, Jesus points to the real issue: "Strive to enter through the narrow door."

The door to eternal life is open, but it is narrow, meaning it requires effort, humility, and commitment. Salvation is not about simply belonging to the right group, having the right label, or being familiar with Jesus. It is about living a relationship of faith and love with Him. Jesus warns that some will say, "We ate and drank with you, and you taught in our streets," but He will reply, "I do not know you." In other words, it is not enough to have external contact with Christ; we must allow His word to transform us, so that our lives bear fruit in love, forgiveness, mercy, and justice.

The first reading from Isaiah reminds us that God desires to gather people from every nation into His Kingdom. The narrow door is open to all, but entering requires a response. It is a daily choice to walk in God's ways, even when the world offers broader and easier paths.

Faith is not passive. We cannot just drift into heaven. We must "strive," which implies effort, prayer, self-denial, and perseverance. Faith is not external. Simply being baptized or coming to Mass without interior conversion is not enough. We must allow Christ to shape our hearts and actions. Faith is universal. The Kingdom of God is not for a select few but is offered to all. Yet, entry requires walking the narrow way of humility and love.

May the Lord give us the grace to enter through the narrow door and may we one day hear the words we all long for: "Come, share your Master's joy."
