Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

The readings for 22<sup>nd</sup> Sunday in ordinary time year c, teach us about humility and the true nature of greatness in the eyes of the Lord.

In the First reading from Sirach, we are reminded to be humble in our relationships with others. 'The greater you are, the more you must humble yourself'. This powerful statement challenges our natural inclinations toward pride and ambition. In a world that often equates success with dominance and prestige, the wisdom of Sirach calls us to a different path, a path of humility. When we approach life with a humble heart, we invite grace into our lives and create a space for God to work through us.

In the Gospel of Luke today, Jesus teaches us through these interactions at a banquet, urging us not to seek the places of honor. Instead, He encourages us to take the lowest place, to live in a posture of service. This radical inversion of social expectations is the hallmark of the kingdom of God. When we invite the poor, the crippled, the lame and the blind into our lives, we shine a light on Christ's. Only the humble accept God's invitation to His banquet. The proud runs the risk not only of being relegated to the last post but of being excluded altogether from God's kingdom. Let us ask the Lord for grace to embrace humility and to open our hearts to the marginalized.

We are the poor whom Jesus invites. We are lame, crippled and blind people incapable of walking alone on the way to heaven. Jesus comes to our daily spiritual gathering to give us a helping hand to see God's plans in our lives and finally to be with Him forever.

In light of the recent and tragic shooting that occurred at a Catholic school during Mass in Minneapolis, we want to take a moment to acknowledge the weight of this news and the concern it may bring. As a precautionary measure, beginning immediately, the church doors will be closed and locked during all school Masses (Daily Mass at 8:30 a.m., all school Masses for holy days at 9:30 a.m.). This step is being taken to ensure a secure environment while our students and staff are gathered in worship. Church doors will be locked by 8:30 a.m. or 9:30 a.m. accordingly during weekday Masses when school is in session.

We continue to pray for peace, healing, and safety for all schools and parishes. Thank you for your trust, understanding, and continued partnership in keeping our community safe.
