# NOVEMBER 16, 2025 THIRTY-THIRD SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME

Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

As we approach the end of the liturgical year, the Church invites us to reflect on the end of all things — not to frighten us, but to awaken us. The readings speak about destruction, suffering, and the coming of the Lord. But their deeper message is one of hope, courage, and steadfast faith. The first reading and the gospel brings our attention that nothing in this world will last forever, injustice and evil will come to an end. The comforting message is that faithfulness in trials leads to life and for those who fear the Lord, "the sun of righteousness will rise with healing in its wings" the Lord is not passive — it's an active hope that shows itself in love and perseverance.

Our world today often feels like it's falling apart — wars, natural disasters, moral confusion, and personal struggles. But Jesus tells us not to be afraid. God's plan is unfolding even in chaos. He asks us to stay faithful, to witness courageously, and to trust that He is with us until the end of time. The true believer does not panic at signs of change or crisis. Instead, he sees them as reminders that this world is passing and that our true home is in God.

Everything earthly is temporary, but God's promises endure forever. Trials are opportunities to witness our faith and trust in God. Perseverance is the key — not giving up even when the world seems dark. Hope is not naïve optimism; it is the confidence that God's light will shine after every storm.




