STAR Testing

All students in grades K through 6 will participate in the STAR standardized testing in September. Students in grades K-6 will be tested in Reading Comprehension on Monday, September 15 and grades 1-6 will be tested in Math on Tuesday, September 16 Testing times will be from 8:30 AM until 10:00 AM both days. I encourage you to make sure your children get the proper rest before the tests, have a healthy breakfast, and bring a book to read should they finish testing early. All students should plan to arrive at school on time each of those days to ensure they have the full time available for testing.

Physical and Dental Forms

Students who are in grades K, 3, and 6 must have a current physical and dental form on file in our school office. This is a state law and is required of all families. Please contact our school office if you need a new form or you may go to our website under student life and then parents.

Hot Lunch Program/Lunchtime Accounts

Our hot lunch program has begun. All St. Rose of Lima students are able to purchase hot lunch and/or milk through our lunch program. Our Cafeteria Manager, Ms. Kaitlin Duff, provided a letter on Back to School Night informing parents what they must do to set up a Lunchtime account. Parents must use the Lunchtime account to purchase hot lunches for their students. A monthly menu will be sent home with students to inform them of the lunch options each day. For your convenience, nutritional information for each meal provided is listed on our school website. In addition, ice cream will be sold on Tuesdays for \$1.00 cash.

Student Planners

Students in grades 3-6 use a school planner to write homework and other important information at the conclusion of each school day. The cost of the planner is \$6.00. Parents may pay by cash or check made payable to St Rose of Lima Elementary School. All money is due by Friday, September 5, 2025. Thank you for your support.

Handbook Highlights

Casual Dress Requirements/Dress Down Days: On certain occasions, students may be granted permission to wear casual apparel to school. The following regulations will be enforced:

- No cut-off jeans or jeans with holes
- Shirts must be long enough to tuck in
- No midriffs or muscle shirts
- No oversized t-shirts may be worn shorts/slacks/skirts must be fully visible below the t-shirt
- No hats, no flip-flops, or pajamas
- Proper undergarments must be worn
- No inappropriate and/or offensive pictures or sayings on clothes
- No writing on seat of any garment
- All clothing must be neat and clean
- No open back shoes/no open toe shoes/no high heels
- Leggings/jeggings/yoga pants may not be worn as a substitute for pants

CHANGE OF ADDRESS OR INFORMATION

Parents/guardians are responsible to ensure St. Rose of Lima Elementary School has up-to-date contact information each school year. Parents must notify the school of changes to mailing addresses, email addresses, phone numbers, parish affiliations, etc. by contacting the school office at 717-792-0889. Certain changes such as name changes will require official documentation.

All families are required to provide the following information to the school on the **first day of school:**

- Parent(s) or guardian(s) name(s)
- Complete and up-to-date address
- Home phone and parent(s) work phone
- Emergency phone number of friend or relative
- Medical alert information
- Email address.

**Your students may be kept out of the classroom if the required emergency information is not on hand for the first day of school as well as required immunizations. It is important that we have communications.

I hope everyone's school year is off to a great start. I'm so excited to be back at St. Rose Elementary again this year! I hope you had a wonderful summer break, and your students are getting back into the routine of school. Unfortunately, transitioning back into the routines and schedules of the school can be challenging at times. This article about <u>Back to School Routine</u> <u>Tips</u> has some helpful tips to make things a little easier as we transition back into school mode. Hopefully, having more days with regular routines under your belt will begin to make things easier.

We have begun classroom Guidance lessons for grades K-6, and I met with almost all of the new students to see how the transition is going for them. My Introductory lessons explained what my role is, and what I do here at St. Rose to help the students in grades K-6 grow and learn. Like last year, the students will have Guidance class lessons every other week, and will often be bringing home activities that we have completed. Along with classroom lessons, I will also be meeting with students individually or in small groups on a short-term basis, when either a teacher or a parent asks me to work with them on something.
