

Kindergarten 2026-2027 Supply List

- 1 backpack
- 1 pk #2 yellow pencils (sharpened with initials on them)
- 1 small pencil sharpener
- 1 large eraser
- 11 plastic - 3-hole folders with pockets, no prongs (2 each - red, blue, yellow)
(1 each -green, purple, orange, white, black)
- 1 pair of headphones (no ear buds or rechargeable) in a labeled Ziploc bag
- 3 large glue sticks (name labeled)
- 1 pk colored pencils
- 1 Pair of clean socks to be used for white board erasers.
- 1 package of 24 crayola crayons (with pink and gry)
- 1 pk of fine point black expo dry erase markers
- 1 child size round tip scissors (name labeled)
- 1 1-inch or 1 ½ inch Avery Durable View 3 ring binder with view front pocket
- 1 paint shirt (labeled)
- 1 refillable water bottle (name labeled)
- 1 large boxes of tissues
- 1 disinfectant wipes
- 1 roll of paper towels

Folders color and labels: 1 red, 1 blue, 1 yellow, please label the inside left side of the pocket as follows: the word **Left**, then under it write, **Leave Home**. On the right inside of the pocket, please write the word **Right**, then under it, write **Right Back**. Please put this set of 3 folders in the 1-inch clear view front pocket binder. The yellow folder will be for their take home or bring back information/work. The right side of the yellow folder is for your messages or office papers to come back. The red folder is for their Language Arts and the blue will be for their Math. The other set of folders (1 each), yellow, red, blue, green, purple, orange, white, and black, please write **Done** on the left side, and **To Do** on the right side. These folders will stay at school in their desks. Please write your child's name on the spine of the binder. In addition, please send in a spare set of clothes in a labeled Ziploc bag in case of an accident. Please include underwear and socks. It doesn't need to be our school uniform, but if you have a spare you may send that in.

Please have your child bring in a picture of something they enjoyed doing over the summer or a picture of a place you visited over vacation. Please also have them bring in their favorite book. We will talk about them during the 1st and 2nd week of school.
