The Nest at St Peter's Church

St Peter's Church warmly invites you to experience Hamish Young's latest poignant and thought-provoking community art installation, which we are delighted to welcome to the church from 23rd-28th September for Portishead

Arts Festival. Nestling inside our welcoming community space of St Peter's Church, you'll find

the Nest: an ambitious sculpture that initially seems to defy the laws of psychics and gravity; a

structure constructed from hundreds of cardboard postal tubes. This humble material allows both artist and visitor to draw on the rich associations of a material so often utilised as protection for objects in transit. You are invited to

write – if you wish – a letter home, to wherever, whenever or whomever that might be, seal this in the special envelope provided and post it in the Nest sculpture. Your message might be one of remembrance or reconciliation, of thanks or hope, something you never got to say or wish you had said, or something else you might want to say.. The message you leave will remain private and unread.

On **Saturday 27th September, 2pm – 4pm, at St Peter's Church**, Hamish will take part in a meet and greet session and an interview about the concept of Nest. An audience Q&A will also be held if there is time.

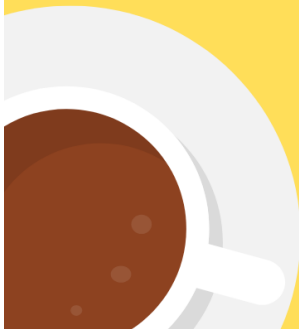
