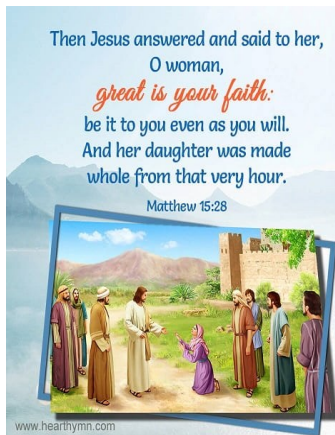

REFLECTION ON THE ASSUMPTION OF THE BLESSED VIRGIN MARY: August 15th we celebrate one of seventeen different memorials, feasts and solemnities in honor of the Blessed Virgin Mary that are found on the Roman Liturgical Calendar. Today's celebration is one of the four great Solemnities by which our Blessed Mother is honored. Obviously, no other person other than our Lord is honored and celebrated with as much solemnity as the Mother of God. The Solemnity of the Assumption honors the fact that when the Blessed Virgin Mary completed her life on earth, she was taken body and soul into Heaven to be with her resurrected Son so as to adore the Most Holy Trinity forever. It's an amazing fact to consider that she retains her body and soul, united as one in Heaven, in anticipation of that glorious day when the new Heavens and Earth will be created and when all the faithful will rise so as to live in a new bodily form forever with God.

THE DIVINE MERCY CHAPLET: We pray the Chaplet after all weekday Masses in the Church. Jesus encourages us to pray this beautiful chaplet daily. Jesus said to St. Faustina "Oh what great graces I will grant to souls who say this Chaplet; the very depths of My tender Mercy are stirred for the sake of those who say the chaplet" (Diary #848). If your schedule permits, we invite you to stay after Mass for a few minutes and pray the chaplet with us.
