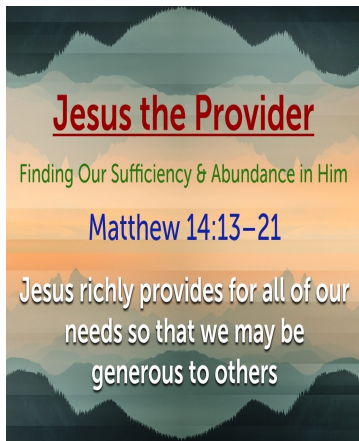

Reflection on Mt. 14:13-21

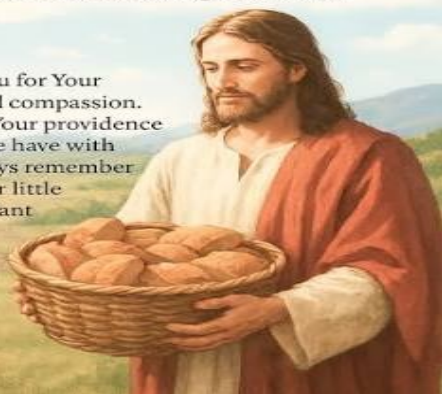
"They all ate and were satisfied, and the disciples picked up twelve basketfuls of broken pieces that were left over."

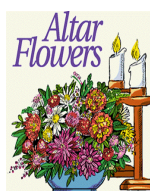
