



THREE PILLARS OF LENT



Fast & Abstinence

MY LENTEN GIFT BOXES: There is a basket at the back of the Church filled with My Lenten Gift Offering boxes. Please take a box and bring back on Easter Sunday with your Lenten Alms. The Lenten Alms from the boxes will be distributed evenly between the Pregnancy Center of the Coastal Bend and the ARK in Corpus Christi.

Prayer, fasting, and almsgiving are the three traditional pillars of Lent. These practices are a way to prepare for Easter and to grow closer to God.

PRAYER: Reading certain Scripture passage in the Bible, Stations of the Cross or other Lenten Devotions, and also praying in the Adoration Chapel.

FASTING: Abstaining from food or drink on certain days such as Ash Wednesday, All Fridays, and Good Friday. Fast from hurting words & say kind words. Fast from sadness & be filled with gratitude, Fast from anger and be filled with patience.

ALMSGIVING: Jesus presented Almsgiving as a part of Christian life, "WHEN you give.." He did not say IF YOU GIVE, but WHEN. The Lenten call to give means making the needs of others your own and sharing.
