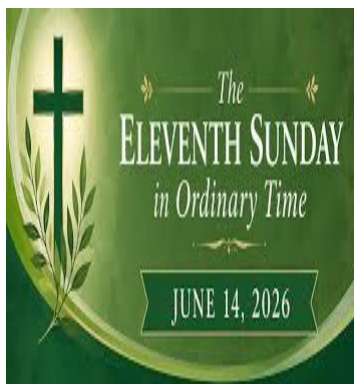

WELCOME TO OUR CHURCH MUSIC MINISTRY:

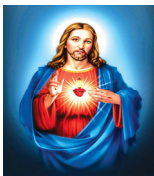

Jesus said to St. Faustina "Oh what great graces I will grant to souls who say this Chaplet; the very depths of My tender Mercy are stirred for the sake of those who say the chaplet" (Diary #848). If your schedule permits, we invite you to stay after Mass for a few minutes and pray the chaplet with us.
