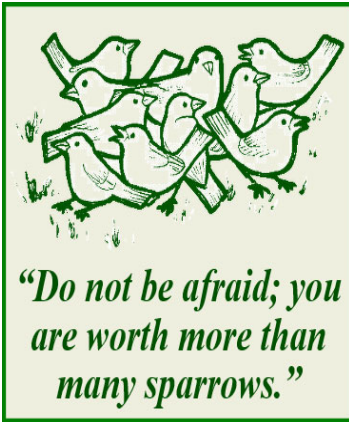

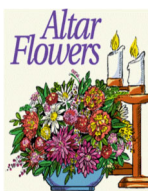

If your schedule permits, we invite you to stay after Mass for a few minutes and pray the chaplet with us.
