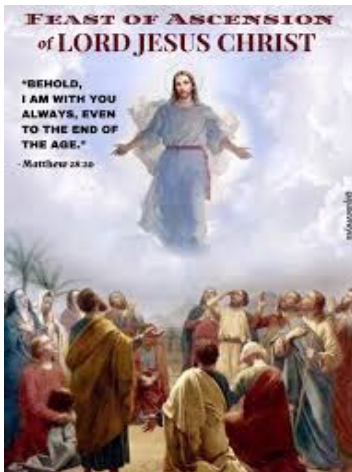

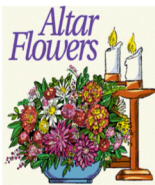
## SINCERE SYMPATHY

***May 17th Ascension of the Lord Reflection:*** *The Ascension of the Lord reminds us that Jesus did not leave the disciples in sadness, but in hope. As He ascended into heaven, He entrusted His mission to his followers: to go forth, proclaim the Gospel, and be witnesses of His love to the ends of the earth. Though Christ returned to the Father, He remains with us always through the Eucharist, His Word, and the presence of the Holy Spirit. The Ascension calls us to lift our hearts toward heaven while still faithfully serving here on earth. It reminds us that our true home is with God, and that every act of kindness, forgiveness, and faith brings us closer to Him. Like the apostles, we are called not to stand still looking upward, but to move forward with courage, trusting that the Lord walks beside us.*

**THE DIVINE MERCY CHAPLET:** We pray the Chaplet after all weekday Masses in the Church. Jesus encourages us to pray this beautiful chaplet daily. Jesus said to St. Faustina "Oh what great graces I will grant to souls who say this Chaplet; the very depths of My tender Mercy are stirred for the sake of those who say the chaplet" (Diary #848). If your schedule permits, we invite you to stay after Mass for a few minutes and pray the chaplet with us.
