First Sunday of Advent November 30th: The first candle on the Advent Wreath represents HOPE—the first Sunday of Advent not only leads us to participate the birth of Christ but celebrate the beginning of a new liturgical season. Purple is the primary color symbolizing royalty, sometimes called the “Prophecy Candle.”



The Advent Season is all about reflecting on how we can prepare our hearts and homes for Christ's birth in the world as it is today. It is a time for faith communities and families to remember, through prayer, reflections, special music, and good deeds what the true meaning of Jesus' birth is. The Advent season invites us to step away from what can be a frenzied time of parties, shopping, and holiday noise to consider how we commemorate the birth of Jesus, one of the holiest times in Christian faith. It is also a time to reflect on the triumphant return of Jesus at the second coming.
