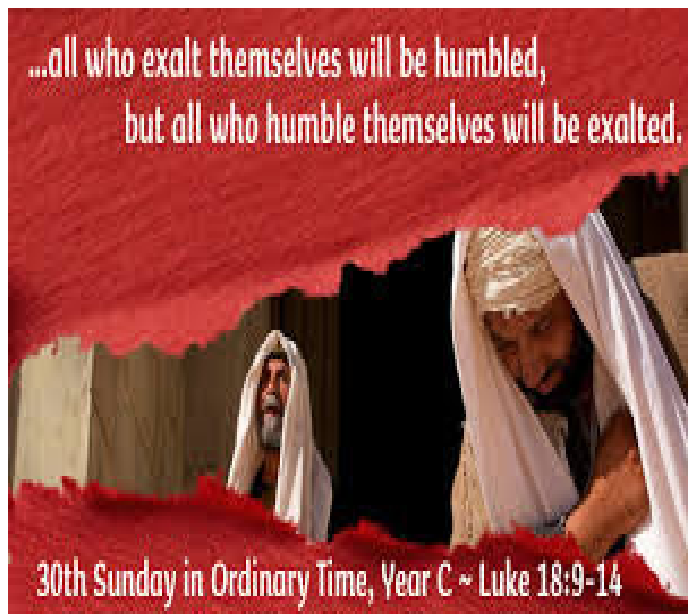

ALL SOULS NOVENA: From Sunday November 2nd to Monday November 10th, our parish will hold a special All Souls Novena—nine Masses offered for the repose of the souls of our departed loved ones. Fr. Patrick warmly encourages everyone to consider enrolling those they wish to remember in this year's novena. The Church has always recognized the profound spiritual power of the Mass, especially when offered for the dead. One remarkable story comes from the life of St. Padre Pio, who was often visited by souls from purgatory seeking prayers. One night, while praying alone, Padre Pio opened his eyes and saw an old man standing before him. Surprised—since the friary doors were locked—he asked, “Who are you? What do you want?” The man replied, “Padre Pio, I am Pietro Di Mauro, son of Nicola, nicknamed Precoco. I died here in 1908, when this friary was a poorhouse. I fell asleep with a lit cigar, and the mattress caught fire. I died a terrible death. I am still in purgatory. God has permitted me to come and ask you for a holy Mass.” Padre Pio comforted him and promised to offer Mass the next day. After some research, he confirmed the man's story—and kept his promise. This was not an isolated event. Padre Pio once said, “As many souls of the dead come up this road to the monastery as souls of the living.” Time and again, souls came seeking the grace of a Mass—reminding us of its spiritual weight and its power to bring peace to those awaiting heaven. Let us follow this example of mercy and love. Enroll your loved ones in the novena, and join us in prayer as we lift them to the light of Christ.

The Ofrenda Altar for All Souls will be set up Thursday, Oct. 30th in the Church. An Ofrenda Altar is a central part of the All Souls Day celebration. Ofrendas are built to honor deceased loved ones and are a way to express love for life and affection for those who have passed. You may start bringing your photos now through Nov 2nd and placing them on the table at the entrance of the church or bring them to the parish office and on Nov 2nd all photos will be placed on the Ofrenda Altar for you.
