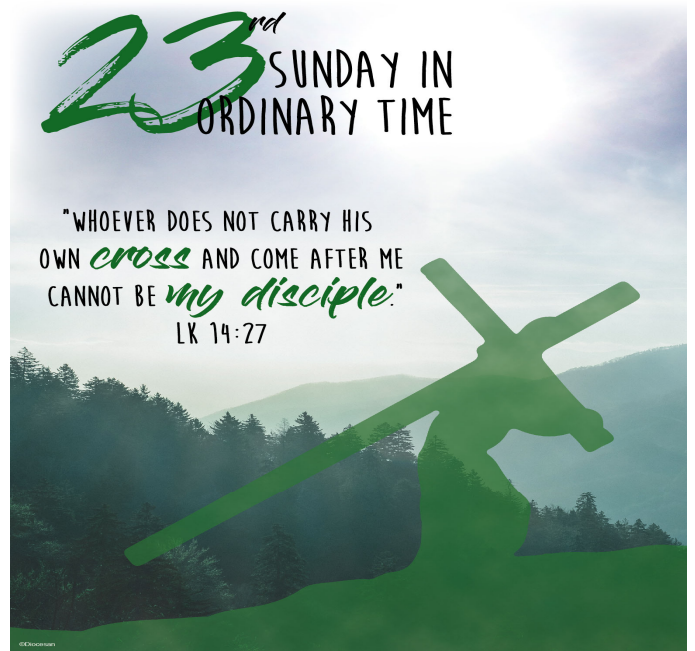

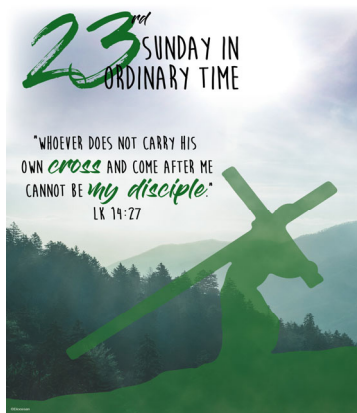

SINCERE SYMPATHY

We offer our sincere condolences and sympathy to Erma Gonzales and the Martinez Family for the recent passing of Joe Martinez, Erma's brother. He will be truly missed by all who knew and loved him. Through The Mercy Of God May Perpetual Light Shine Upon Him And May He Rest In Peace.

Today September 7th Carlo Acutis and Pier Giorgio Frassati were canonized as Saints by Pope Leo XIV. Carlo Acutis born 1991, was a devout Italian teenager known as the "first millennial saint" for his use of the internet to spread devotion to Eucharistic miracles and his profound faith in Jesus through the Eucharist. After his First Communion at age seven, he attended daily Mass and adoration, calling the Eucharist his "highway to heaven". He was also known for his kindness, using his computer skills to create a website documenting Eucharistic miracles, which has been displayed worldwide. Despite suffering from leukemia, he died at 15, but his life of faith and two credited miracles led to his beatification in 2020 and set him for canonization.

Blessed Pier Giorgio Frassati was a 20th-century Italian Catholic who exemplified faith, social justice, and a love for the outdoors, becoming a patron for youth, athletes, and ordinary people. Born to a wealthy family, he lived a life of poverty, giving away his resources to the poor, and was dedicated to serving them through organizations like the Society of Saint Vincent de Paul. Known for his joyful spirit and mountaineering, he mottoed his favorite hobby with the phrase "Verso l'alto" ("to the heights"). He died at age 24 from polio, a disease likely contracted from the people he served, and is scheduled for canonization.
