Surgery and Anesthesia Authorization

Modern anesthetics and surgical procedures have made animal surgery quite routine and safe. We take all necessary precautions with every surgery patient.

Every animal gets a physical examination before surgery along with a pre-anesthetic blood test. The blood test focuses mainly on liver and kidney function. These two organs are responsible for flushing out toxins in the body, such as the anesthesia that will be used during surgery. It makes sure they are functioning properly prior to the anesthesia. If there is an abnormality the doctor will reconsider doing the surgery. Your animal also receives a post-surgical pain injection that makes them more comfortable the first night home.

There are always risks involved in surgery and anesthesia. We think you should realize this when authorizing an elective surgery. We agree to do our best.
