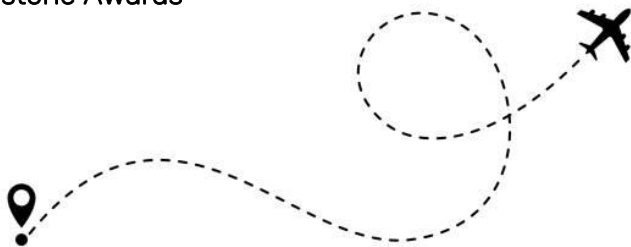

As I reflect on the past 14 months, this quote seems to sum up life so completely. Although we are fewer in numbers, I am delighted to welcome you to ***Destination Unknown***, a journey of places both real and imaginary, proudly presented by the talented students of LeRoux School of Dance.

This season marks the last performance for two special dancers at LeRoux. The first adventure I'd like to highlight is that of Allison Meyer who began dancing at LeRoux in the spring of 2008. Her first recital's theme was ***Philadelphia Freedom*** in 2009, and she performed in "Al Albert's Showcase" to ***Baby Take A Bow***. Her mom recently shared that Allie wasn't so sure she would continue with dance until she got the recital recording and watched it at home. That's when she declared, "I want to do ***that*** again." Born to perform, Allie became a member of the Steppers Dance Team, participated in, and won our Student Choreography competition, and is a member of both ***Raising the Barre*** and our Student Teacher program. Over the years, she has enjoyed being a soloist in our annual Nutcracker productions, participating in local community event performances and traveling to Washington DC, Florida and California to perform. Allie is an award-winning soloist and will share her performance of, ***She Used to Mine*** on Monday. In addition, I am thrilled to say that you will get to see her choreographic talents performed by our student teacher program members on both Wednesday and Monday in Studio 54, 1979 and ***The Future***. Allie is heading to Tampa, Florida in August and I wish her the best as she begins her new adventure!

Director's Note

Up next, Molly Pizzuta, who enrolled in classes in the fall of 2008 and also performed in *Philadelphia Freedom*. Her first recital dance was "Italian Market" to the song, *The Tarantella*. I remember well when Molly began dancing because her mom was sure that she would be too shy to dance on stage, which she reminded me of when it was time to order costumes and prepare for dress rehearsal that season. As you've already guessed, Molly took an instant love to performing! Molly was the first 7-year-old to join The Steppers and at age 8 performed more than 8 dance numbers in our annual recital inspiring many students to follow in her footsteps over the next few years. She participated in the student choreography competition, community performances, Student Teacher program, *Raising The Barre*, was an ambassador for Traveling Tutus, a soloist in the Nutcracker and traveled to Washington DC, Florida and California to perform. Her dedication led to achievements like having the highest scoring solo performance on our team, including her final competitive performance on May 30, 2021 where she received an almost perfect score, 295 points out of a possible 300, and an invitation to attend *Battle on the Seas* in January. On Monday, Molly will perform this solo, **Sun** with us as she takes the stage for the last time at LeRoux. Staying in PA next year, her next chapter will begin at PITT in August. Wishing you much success as you continue your journey, Molly!

Meet Our Teachers

Don Nee started dancing at age 12 doing all the popular dances of the time and continued from there to study many other forms of dance. Among these are ballet, tap, jazz, jitterbug, swing, disco, rock n' roll line dancing, country line dancing, hip-hop and various forms of ballroom. During the past 25 years, Mr. Don's credits include many performances at area schools, malls, universities and festivals throughout the Delaware Valley. Other highlights include the Bicentennial Celebration at Elfreths Alley, The Philadelphia Auto Show, The Opera Company of Philadelphia, Taylor Hospital's Annual Gala Fundraiser, The Mummers Show of Shows, The Phantom Fountain, The William Penn Award Celebration to the Mayor of Philadelphia held in the ballroom, *Atop the Bellevue*, and Excerpts from The Nutcracker on AM Philadelphia and Captain Noah. Mr. Don has performed professionally for many area company's corporate functions i.e., CIGNA and Bell Atlantic. One of Mr. Don's most notable achievements was dancing the lead male role in the Valley Forge and Westbury Music Fair's annual productions of *The Nutcracker* for 20 years. Since 2013 Mr. Don has been challenging the ballet students here at LeRoux.

Tia DiPietro is originally from Northern New Jersey and is a graduate of DeSales University holding a BA in Dance, and a graduate of Temple University holding an MFA in Dance and Choreographic Studies. Technically trained in ballet, modern, and jazz she has created two original pieces that have been showcased in New York (Dance New Amsterdam), Pennsylvania (Emerging Choreographers Concert), and Wisconsin (ACDFA). She is currently developing a program for Bucks County Community College where she is on the staff and has been performing professionally with Contempra Dance Theater. Her repertoire includes performance credits all over the United States. Joining our staff in 2020, Miss Tia enjoys teaching Improv, Jazz and Lyrical on Monday evenings and setting choreography for our performances and competition dancers.

Meet Our Teachers

Brooke Moses began dancing at the age of 7 and has been performing ever since. Since graduating, she has joined the Reading Royals Ice Angels to perform at Reading Royals Ice Hockey home games and actively engage with the crowd in the Santander Arena. Miss Brooke believes dancing is a great outlet which allows dancers to grow in a fun and healthy manner into confident performers. She is super excited to begin her career with Le Roux Dance School! Welcome Miss Brooke, we are excited to have you teaching Twinkle Star dance and hip hop for our ShowStars.

Meghan McCall made her teaching debut at LeRoux in February 2015 and has been dancing, performing, and competing since 1995. As a dance student, she assisted with ballet and jazz instruction while in high school and performed several featured roles in her studio's Nutcracker Performance including Dewdrop Fairy and Lead Marzipan. Miss Meghan is a graduate of Susquehanna University, where she earned a minor in Dance, was a choreographer and instructor of jazz, lyrical, and ballet classes offered in the University's student-run dance studio. Miss Meghan was the President of Susquehanna University Dance Corps for two years, where her responsibilities included scheduling classes and coordinating various sized productions, as well as promotion of both the dance program and its events. Since graduation, she has been providing jazz, contemporary, and ballet instruction to dancers ages 4 through teen. She resides in Berwyn with her husband, Peter, and their cat, Odell.

She has been showcased in Le Ballets de l'Opera Chinois de New York's Chinese New Year Gala and has modeled for Bliss Lau in New York City's Fashion Week, 2011. A native of Pennsylvania, she is excited to bring all the experiences she gained in New York City home with her. This year, Miss Lauren added Twinkle Star and Show Stars dancers to her musical theater and ballet class schedule at LeRoux and has enjoyed every minute of it. In October, her family bought their first home and are enjoying their new neighbor and short commute to the studio! Meet Our Teachers

Karin (Logan) Flanagan is an award-winning choreographer with a wide variety of training in jazz, ballet, and tap. Her thirst for knowledge has taken her to several masterclasses with prestigious teachers Bob Rizzo, Sheila Barker, Greg Russell, Barry Youngblood, Karen Cleighton, and the late Al Gilbert. She continues to educate herself through participation in dance conventions and teacher training seminars and is a Certified Early Childhood Dance Instructor. 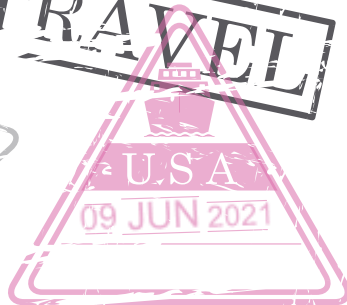

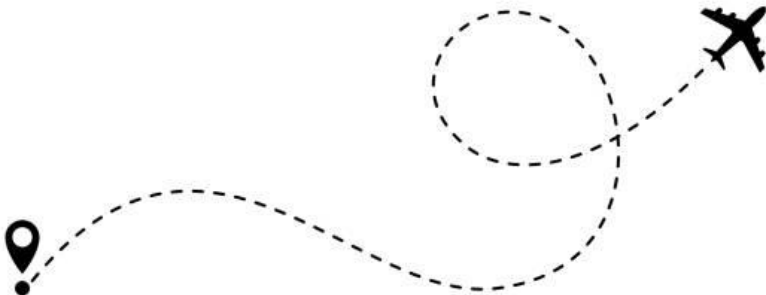

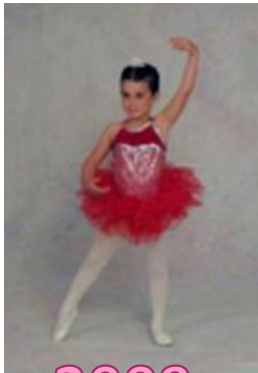
