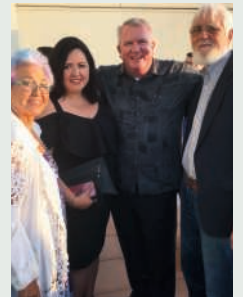
Fiscal Sponsorship

Become a Member: Frequently Asked Questions



By becoming a member, you will join a network of hundreds of leaders from academia, business and corporate partners, government agencies, nonprofit organizations, and leading local, regional, state, national, and international philanthropies.

When is it a good time to join BPP?

The answer is simple. It is always a good time to join BPP! We offer resources and support for every type of organization and individual, from those just starting out to partners who have been working in philanthropy for decades. Join today to start receiving the many benefits of becoming a member.

I don't live in the U.S.-Mexico Border Region. Can I join?

Yes, BPP members are located throughout the U.S. and Mexico. If you have vested interests in the U.S.-Mexico Border region we welcome you to be part of our growing network.

Can an organization join at the Individual Level?

Organizations are encouraged to join at the Institutional Level or higher to receive the many services that BPP can provide to strengthen your philanthropic activities. The Individual Level membership is designed to be used only by a person, typically consultants that want to stay informed of Border news via our newsletters. Membership benefits are limited to monthly newsletters and reduced fees at conferences, events, virtual trainings, workshops, and seminars.

Does BPP support political activities?

BPP is an apolitical organization. We support organizations and causes. We do not engage, support, or endorse political parties in the United States or Mexico.

How long is BPP membership?

Memberships are valid for one year and all memberships are renewed annually.

What happens after membership dues are paid?

After dues have been paid, you will send your "Membership Profile" and proof of payment to info@borderpartnership.org. Once your "Membership Profile" has been submitted you will receive a link to subscribe to BPP's newsletters. Members at the Institutional Level or higher will also receive a membership kit. If you would like to request specific services, please contact BPP at info@borderpartnership.org.

How do I know when my membership expires?

Once membership dues are received by BPP, you will be provided with a paid receipt. The receipt includes the membership period and the renewal date. BPP will also send a renewal reminder one month before your membership renewal due date.

Membership Levels
