Additional musicians (brass, strings, voice, etc.) are welcome but are contingent upon the approval of the director. Specific requests regarding music not listed on the Wedding Music List also need approval. The church remains a sacred space where the Blessed Sacrament is present. Requests should be proper to the ceremony and respect the presence of Christ.
For any wedding that has music, both an organist and cantor are required. The organist is the principal musician and will be present at every wedding that has music regardless of outside musicians being contracted.
A cantor will be scheduled for your wedding by the Director of Music. If you have a request for a specific cantor, please list their name here:
Prelude Music will begin 20 minutes prior to the wedding time and include organ solos determined by the organist. If there is a specific request for prelude music, please list it here:
The Responsorial Psalm between the first and second readings will be sung by the cantor. Please submit the text you have chosen to the Music Department so that the organist and cantor may choose the appropriate musical setting for the text. If the psalm has been chosen, please specify which one
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Please Note: "Here Comes the Bride" and "Wedding March" from Mendelsohn's *A Midsummer's Night Dream* are not appropriate for use in the church and are therefore not allowed.

The Gospel Acclamation ("Alleluia") is always sung apart from weddings that fall during the liturgical season of Lent in which the acclamation will be "Praise to you, Lord Jesus Christ."
