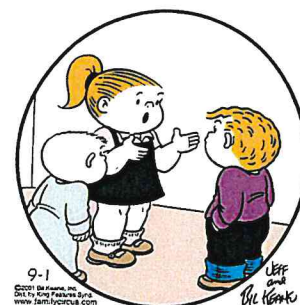

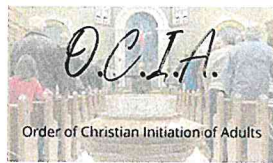




**FORTY HOURS EUCHARISTIC DEVOTIONS**
