Our guest homilist will be Fr. Michael Messner. Mark your calendars now and plan to join us during these grace-filled days in our parish.

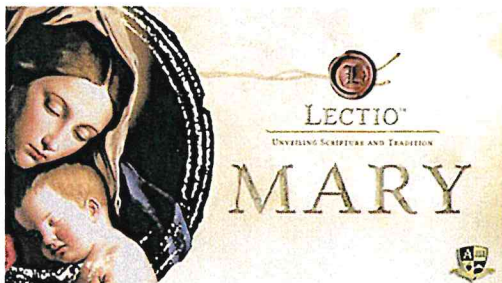
### **88th Annual Conewago District Council of Catholic Women Mass and Dinner**

**Our annual Parish Picnic is scheduled for Sunday, September 28th from 12:30-4:30 PM.**

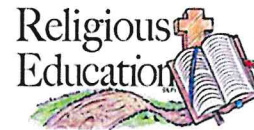
