

The 2026 Diocesan Campaign for kicks off next weekend. Our goal this year is **\$64,548.00**. Roughly \$157.00 less than last year. We went over our goal of \$64,704.46 in 2025 by **\$5,469.63**. We contributed \$70,174.09. The overage came back to the parish and was put in the Savings. Out of 462 households last year, 162 participated.
