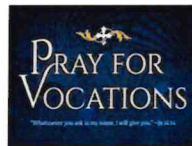
**MEMORIAL MASS**

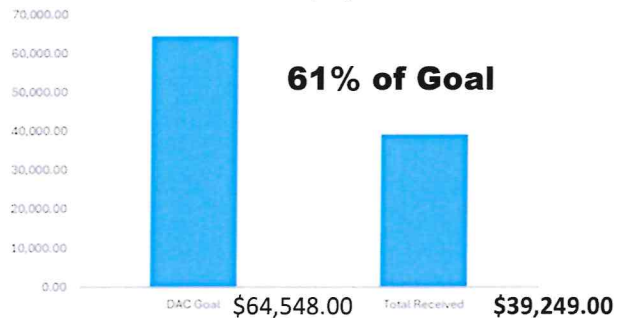
